

STUDENT AND PARENT(S) CERTIFICATIONS

WARNING: Federal regulations state that purposely giving false or misleading information may result in a fine, a prison sentence, or both.

- I certify that the information I have provided to support my application is true and correct to the best of my knowledge. I understand that my application may be verified against my federal tax returns. If any items are determined to be inaccurate, my aid will be adjusted immediately.
- I certify that I do not owe a refund on any grant or loan, am not in default on any student loan, and have not borrowed in excess of the loan limits under the Title IV programs, at any institution. I will use any money received only for expenses related to my education at Cornell College.
- I understand that my tuition and other charges assessed by Cornell College are my responsibility, whether or not I qualify for financial assistance.
- I understand that if I am registered for fewer than eight (8) terms per year, my college charges and financial assistance will be adjusted accordingly.
- I understand that my financial assistance will be paid by credit to my student account for tuition, fees, room, and board. I authorize the use of my financial assistance proceeds to cover other charges incurred by me or assessed by the college according to the published financial assistance policies.
- I will NOT receive a Federal Pell Grant for more than one school for the same period of time.
- I authorize the Financial Assistance staff at Cornell College to discuss my application and to provide necessary academic/biographical information to other colleges, donors, agencies, or organizations who provide funds or assist in their collection. Academic information includes but is not limited to academic transcripts.
- I understand that the Financial Assistance Office reserves the right to request additional information and/or supporting documentation in order to accurately assess my financial status (C.F.R. Title 34, Part 668, the student financial aid program rules).
- I certify that if I am a male between the ages of 18 and 26, I am registered with Selective Services.
- I certify that I am a U.S. citizen or an eligible non-citizen.
- Enrolled students receiving permission and choosing to live off-campus (without parents) will have their institutional, need-based financial aid adjusted proportionally to their actual college charges. The types of institutional aid that may be impacted are limited to Cornell need-based endowed scholarships and grants. All Cornell merits scholarship or awards, federal or state grants, outside scholarships or awards, or loans will not be altered. Merit scholarships for commuting students (living with parents) are limited to no more than \$12,500 per year.
