Oral Script for Chapter 3a

Role Play

1. The child gives a command (left column) and the unsympathetic parent responds, "It is not possible to ____."

Child:

κάθιζε

λάμβανε τὸ βιβλίον

αἶρε τὸ βιβλίον

ἀναγίνωσκε τὸ βιβλίον

φέρε τὸ βιβλίον

κάλει τὸν φίλον/τὴν φίλην

βλέπε πρὸς τὸν φίλον/τὴν φίλην

ἄγε τὸν φίλον/τὴν φίλην

βάδιζε ἐκ τοῦ οἴκου

μένε ἐν τῷ οἴκῳ

προσχώρει μοι (3α)

πίπτε ἐκ τοῦ δένδρου

πόνει

λεῖπε (3β) τὸ ἄροτρον

λύε (3β) τοὺς βοῦς

κάθειδε

Parent: οὐ δύνατόν ἐστι + infinitive

Example: οὐ δύνατόν ἐστι καθίζειν.

2. The child says the s/he wishes to do something and the unsympathetic parent responds, "It is not possible to ____." Use the verbs above.

Pattern:

Child: ἐθέλω + infinitive

Parent: οὐ δύνατόν ἐστι ____.

Example: ἐθέλω καθίζειν

Example: οὐ δύνατόν ἐστι καθίζειν.

3. A sympathetic parent asks the child, "Do you wish to ____?" Now the child responds "I do (not) want to ____." Use the verbs above.

Pattern:

Parent: ἄρ' ἐθέλεις + infinitive?

Child: (οὐκ) ἐθέλω + infinitive.

Example: ἄρ' ἐθέλεις πονεῖν;

Example: οὐκ ἐθέλω πονεῖν.
