Payment #1: \$1200 due October 1 Payment #2: \$1200 due Dec 1 Final Payment: ~\$1200 due Feb 1

You may make the initial payment by submitting \$400 (cash/check/money order) to the Cashier's window on the first floor of Old Sem (indicate that the payment should be applied to the Classics course in Greece).
