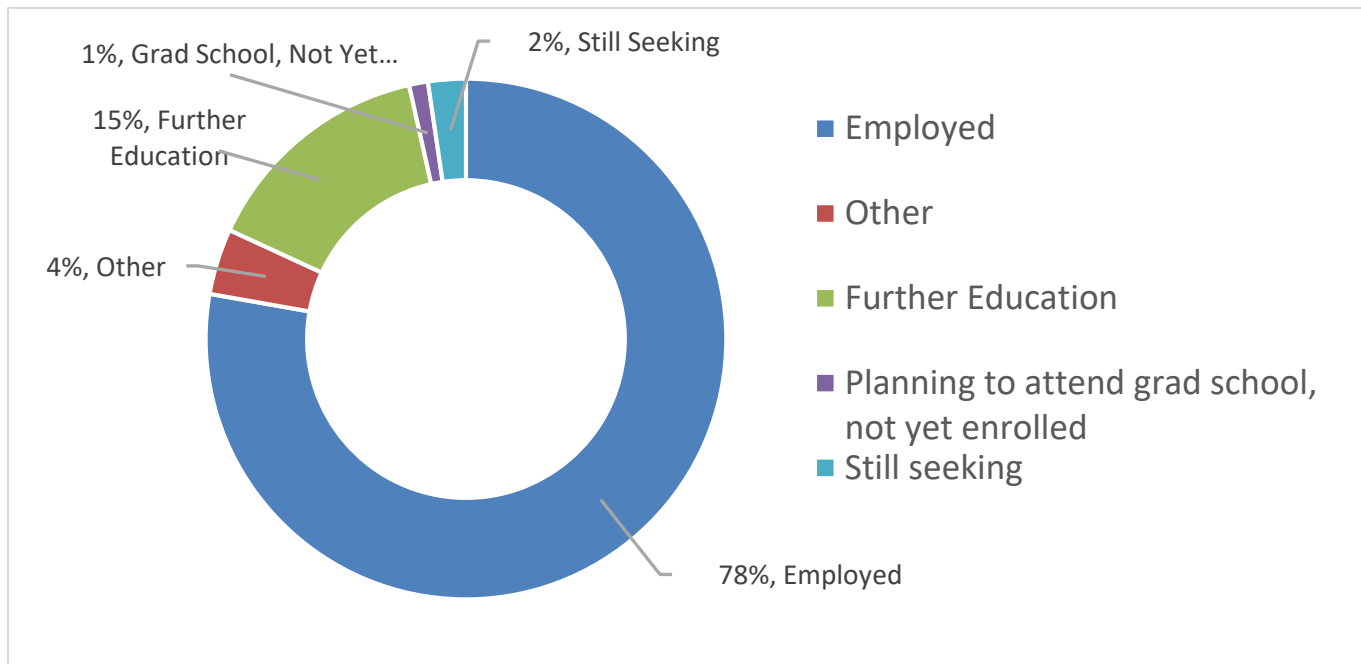

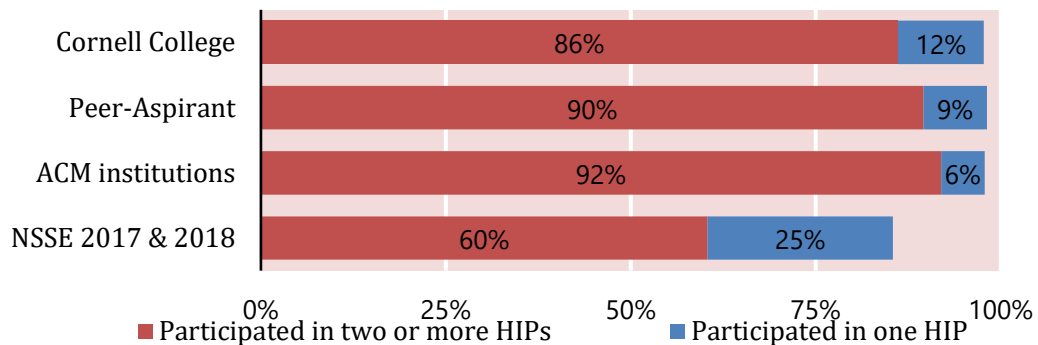

Graduates High Impact Practice Participation*

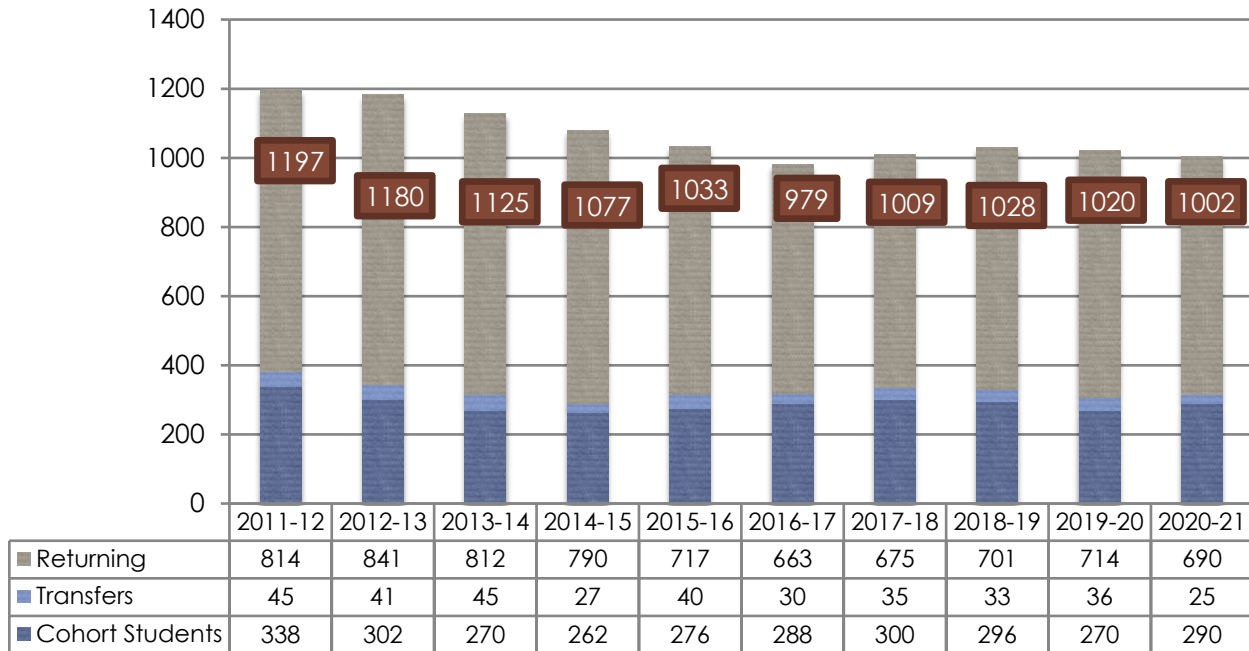

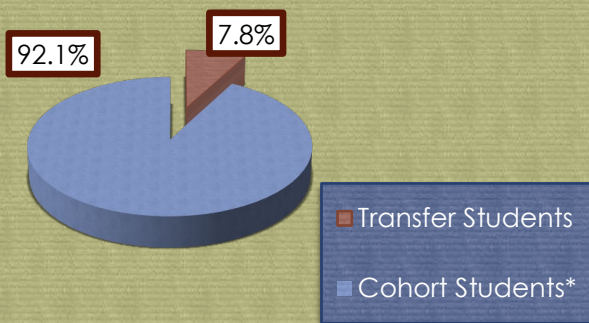

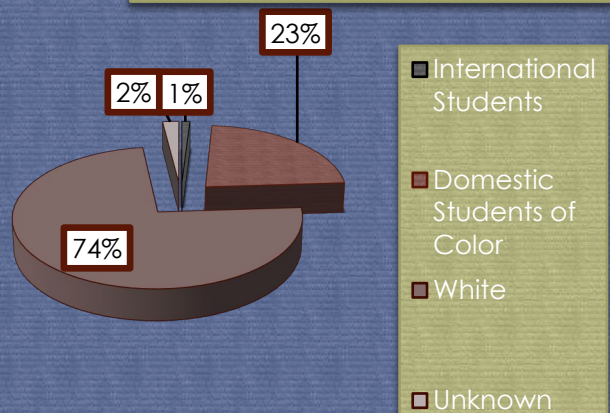

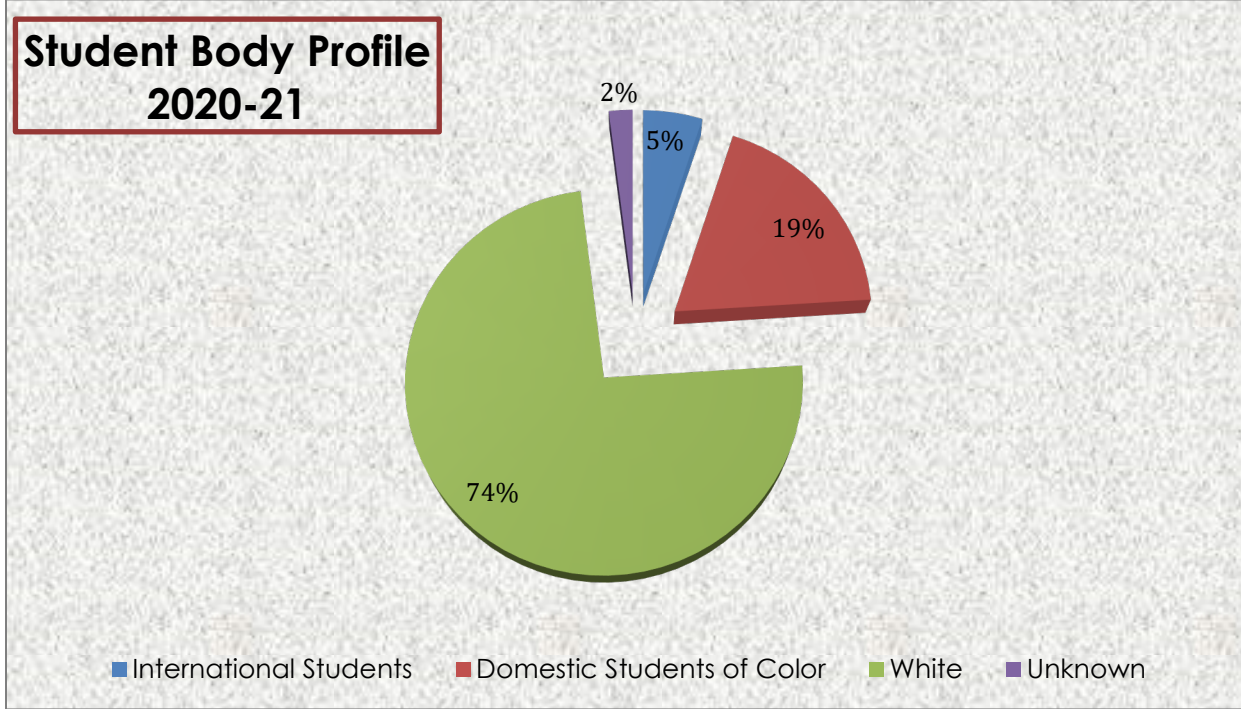
Breakdown of Students Incoming Class 2020-21



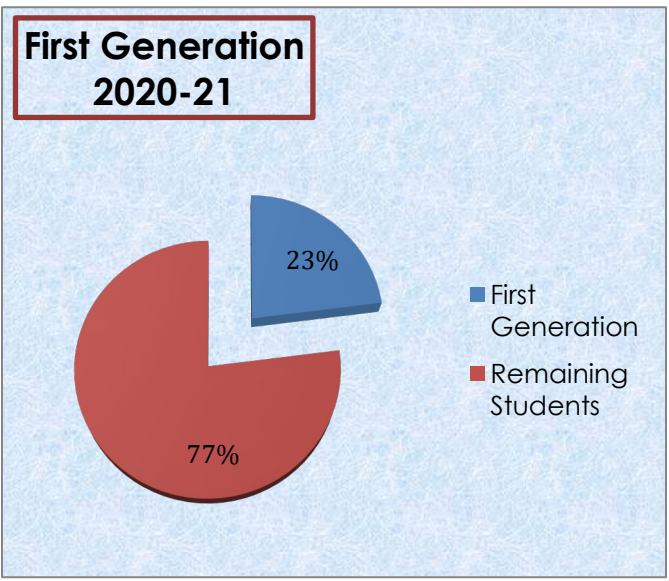
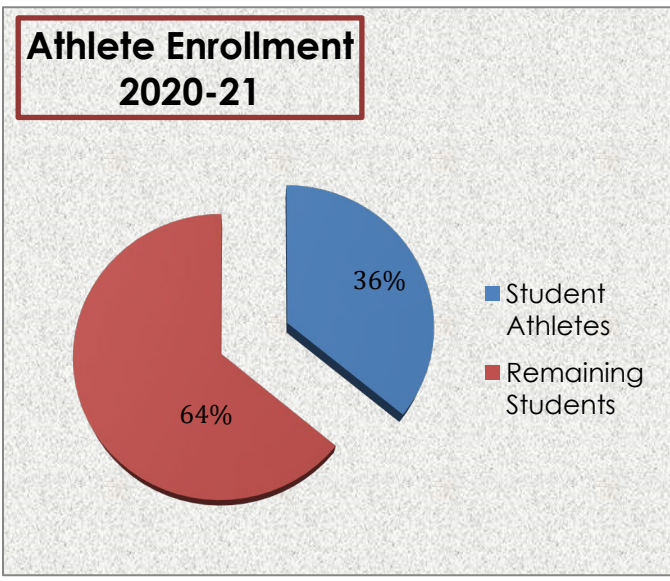
Demographic Breakdown 2020 Cohort



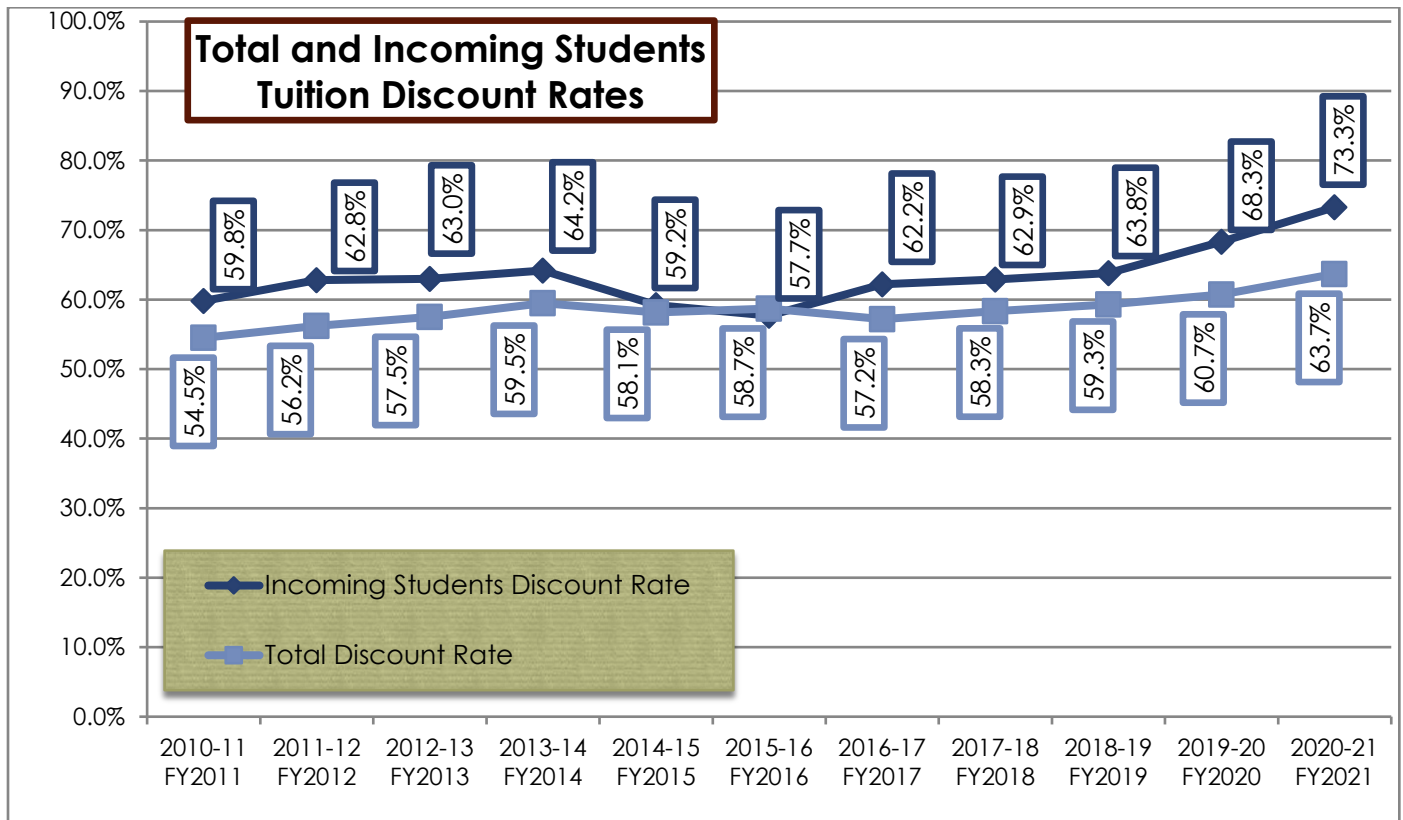

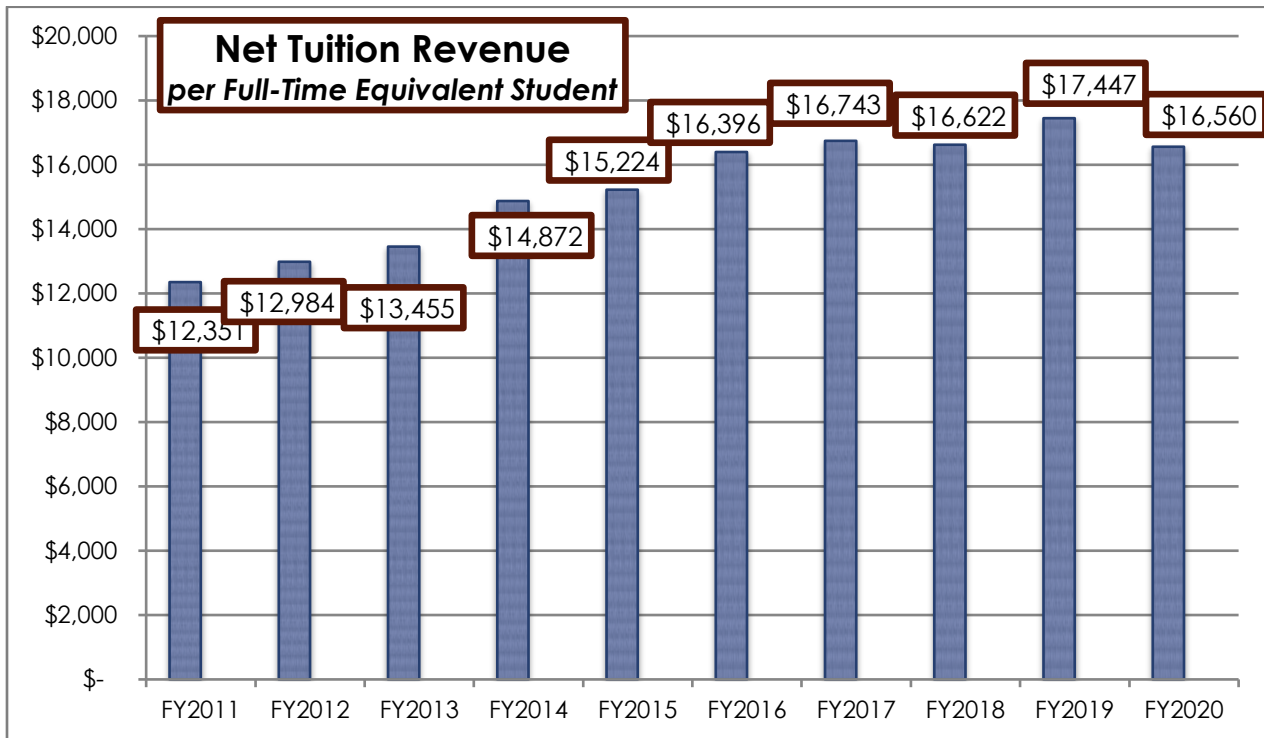

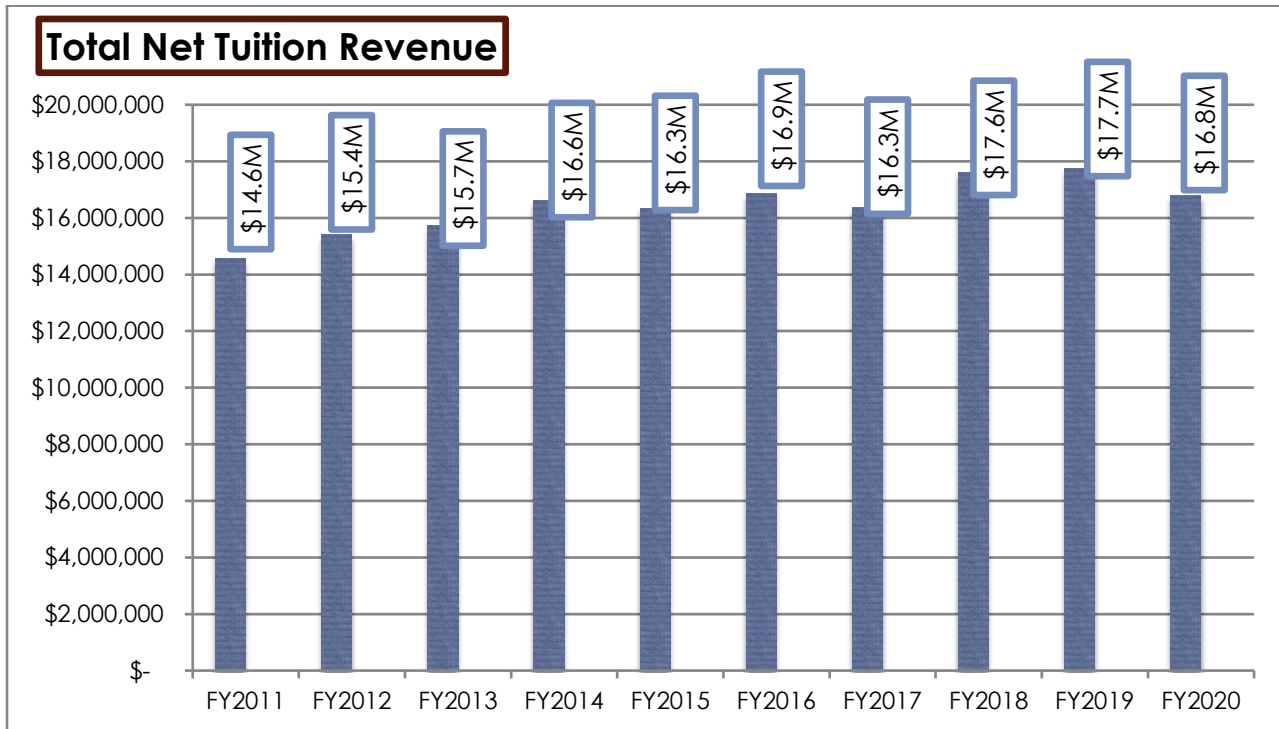

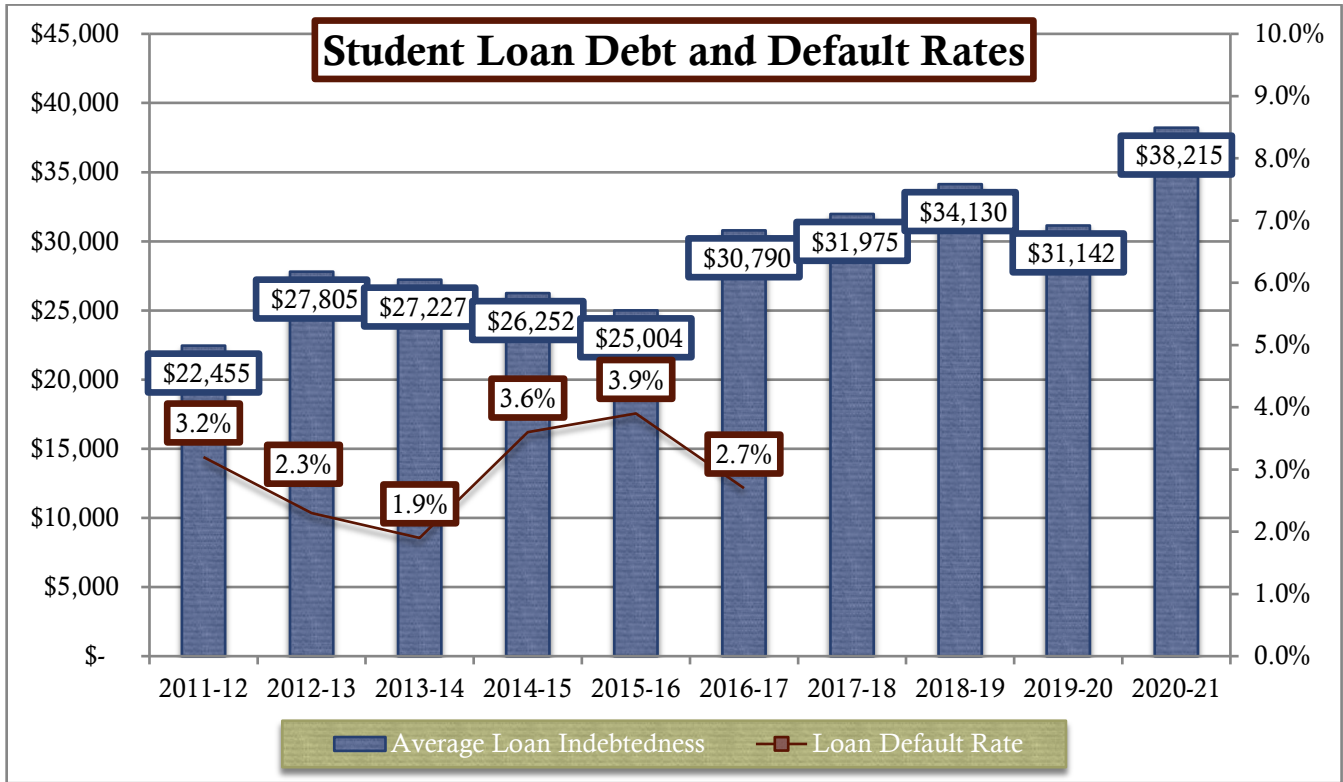

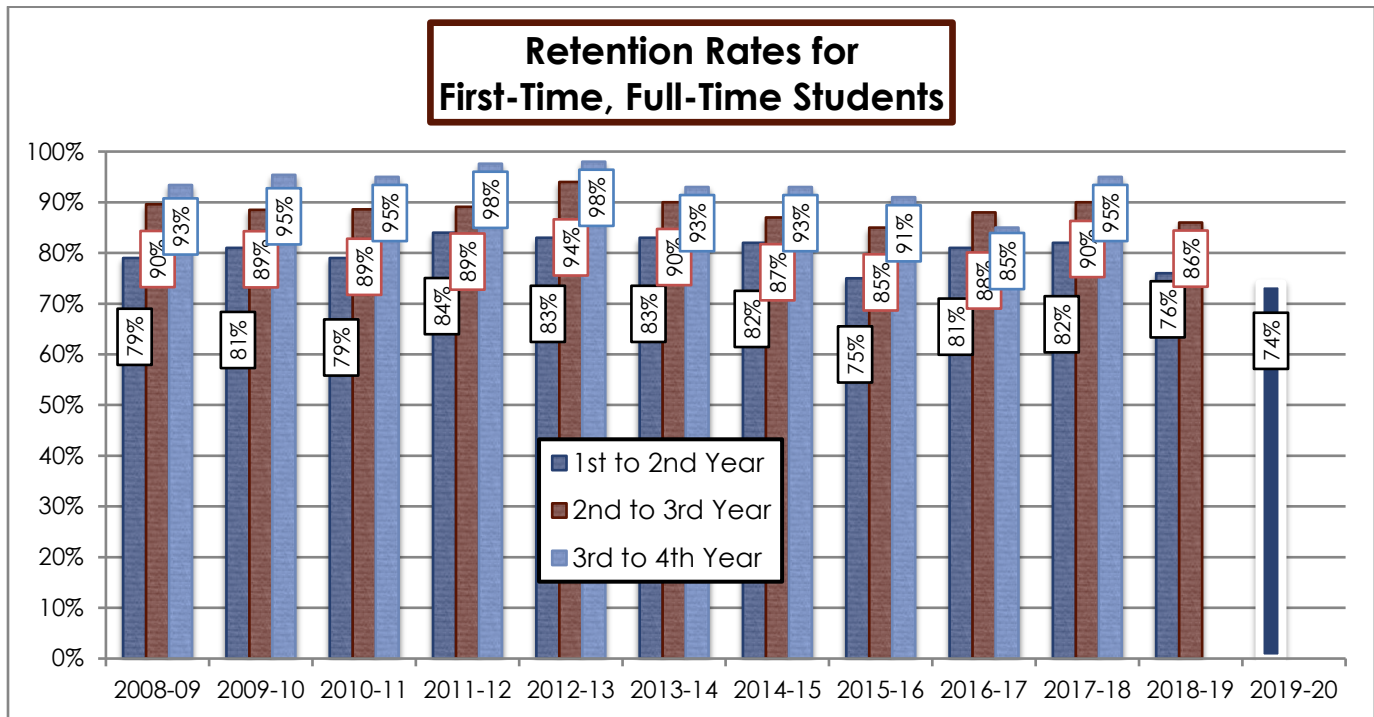

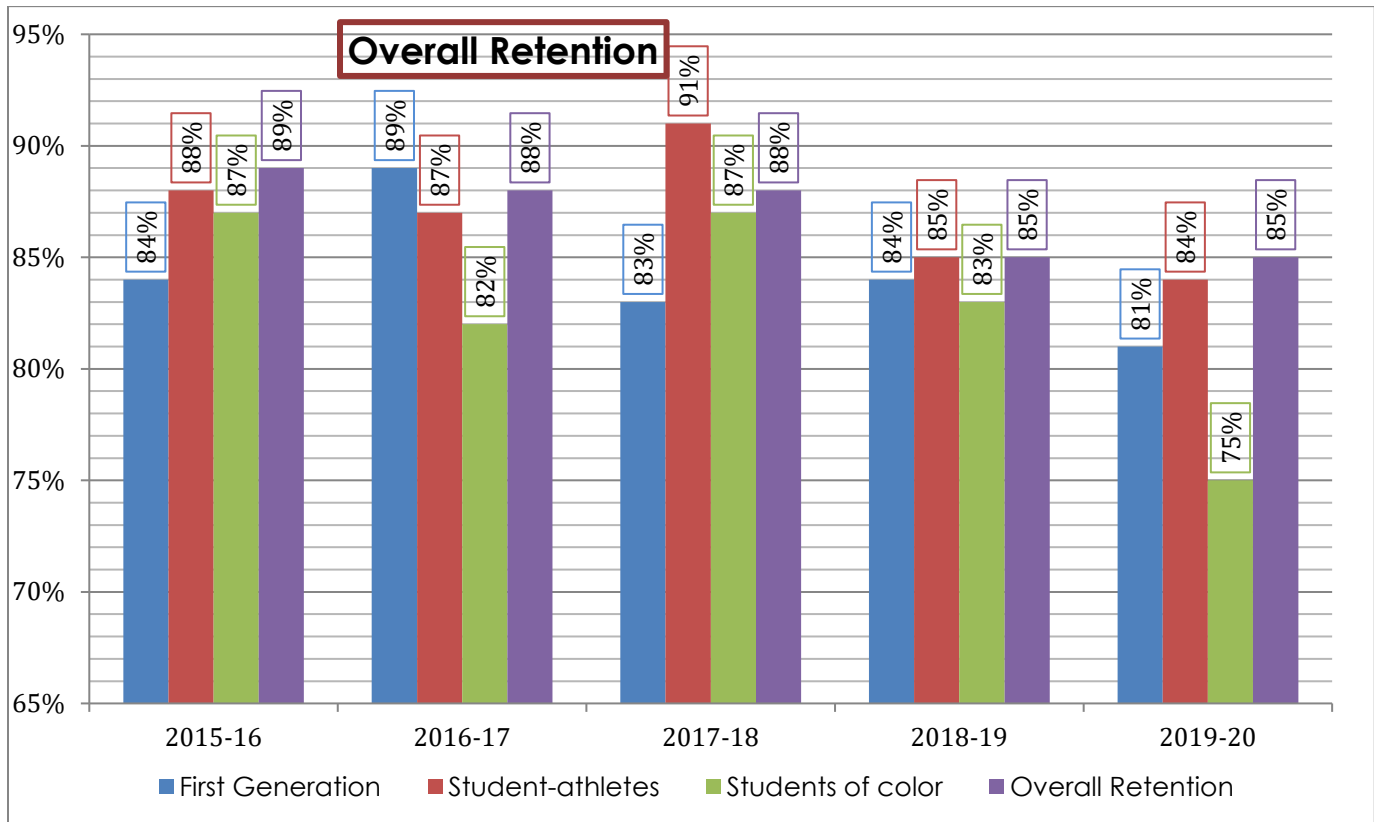

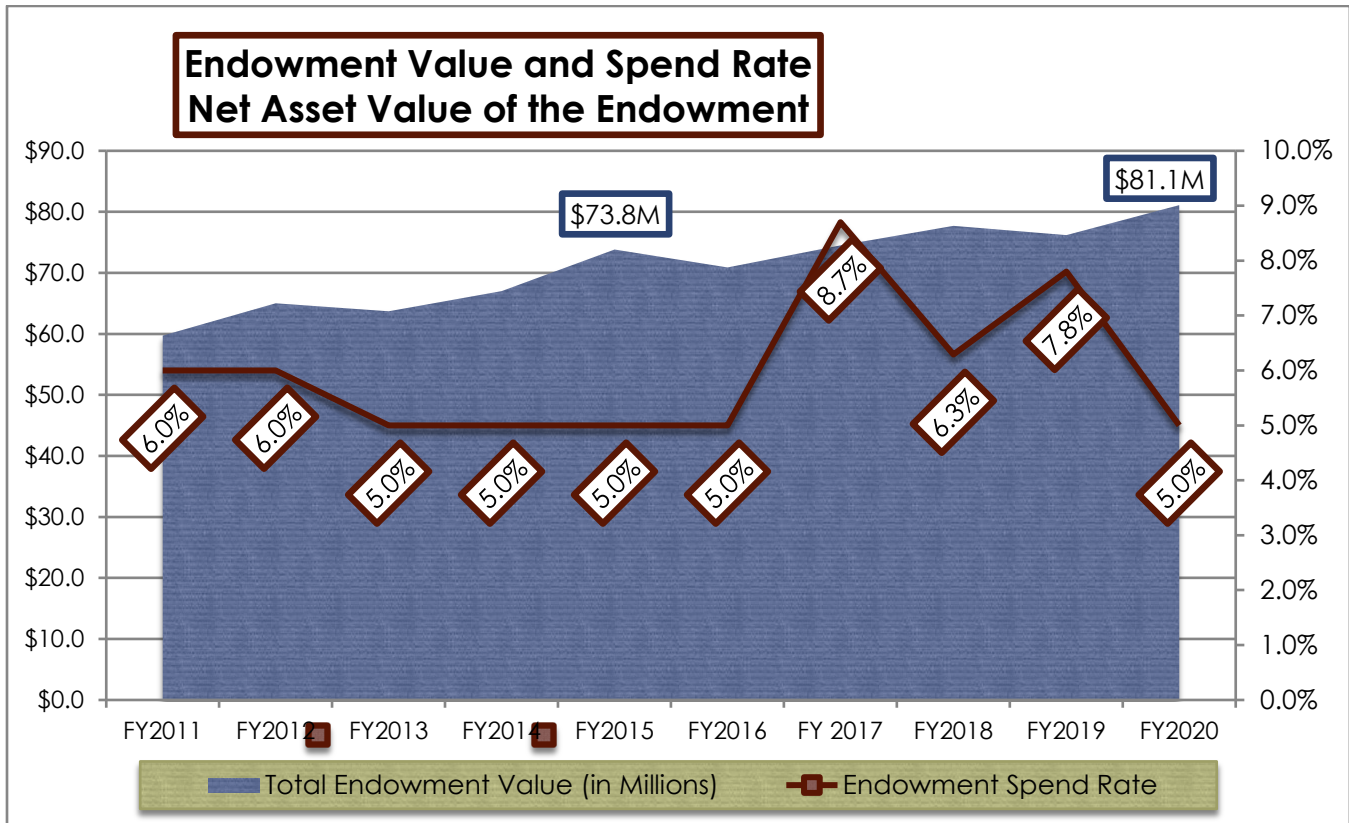




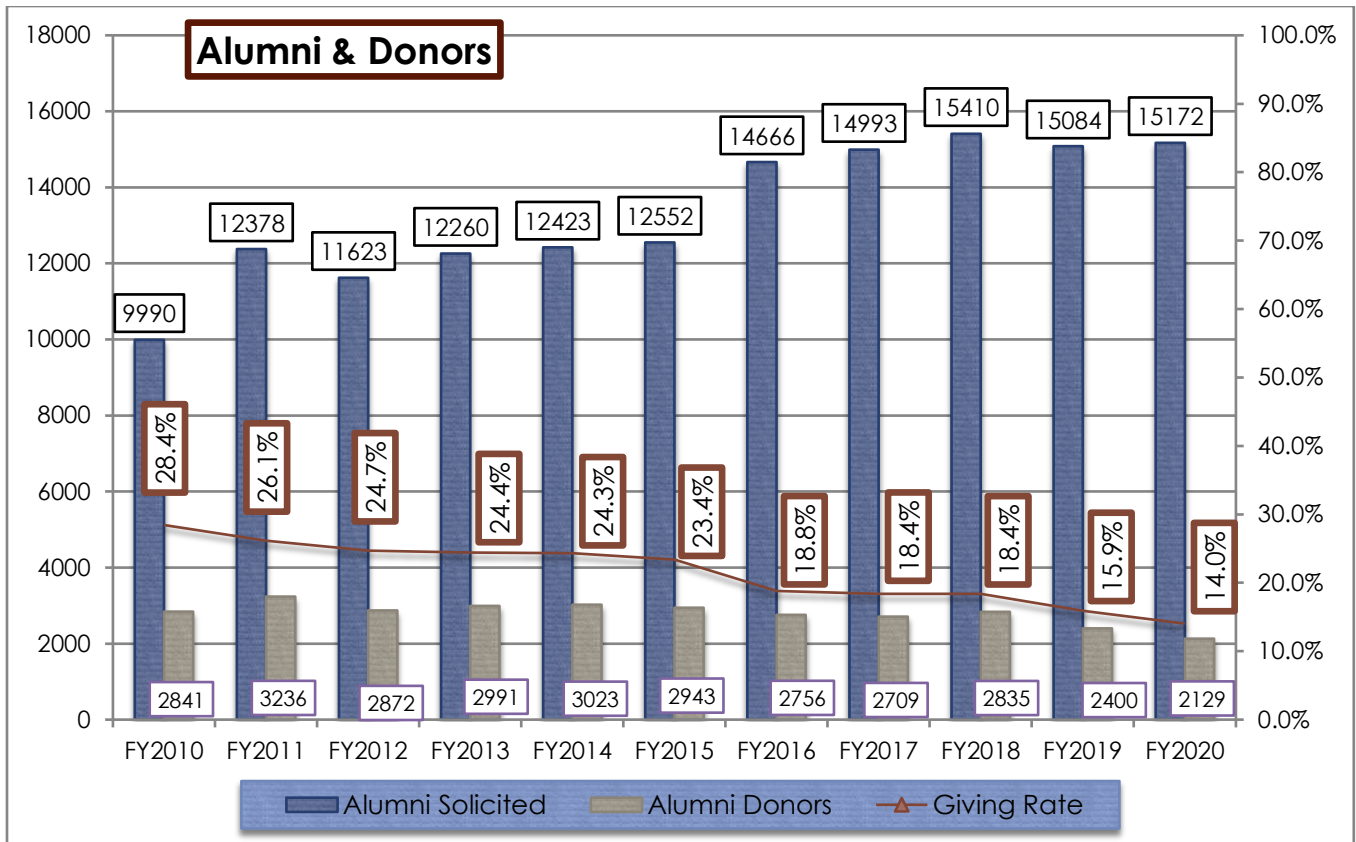
Horizontal line represents the first to second year retention rate (75%) of the 2015 Cohort.

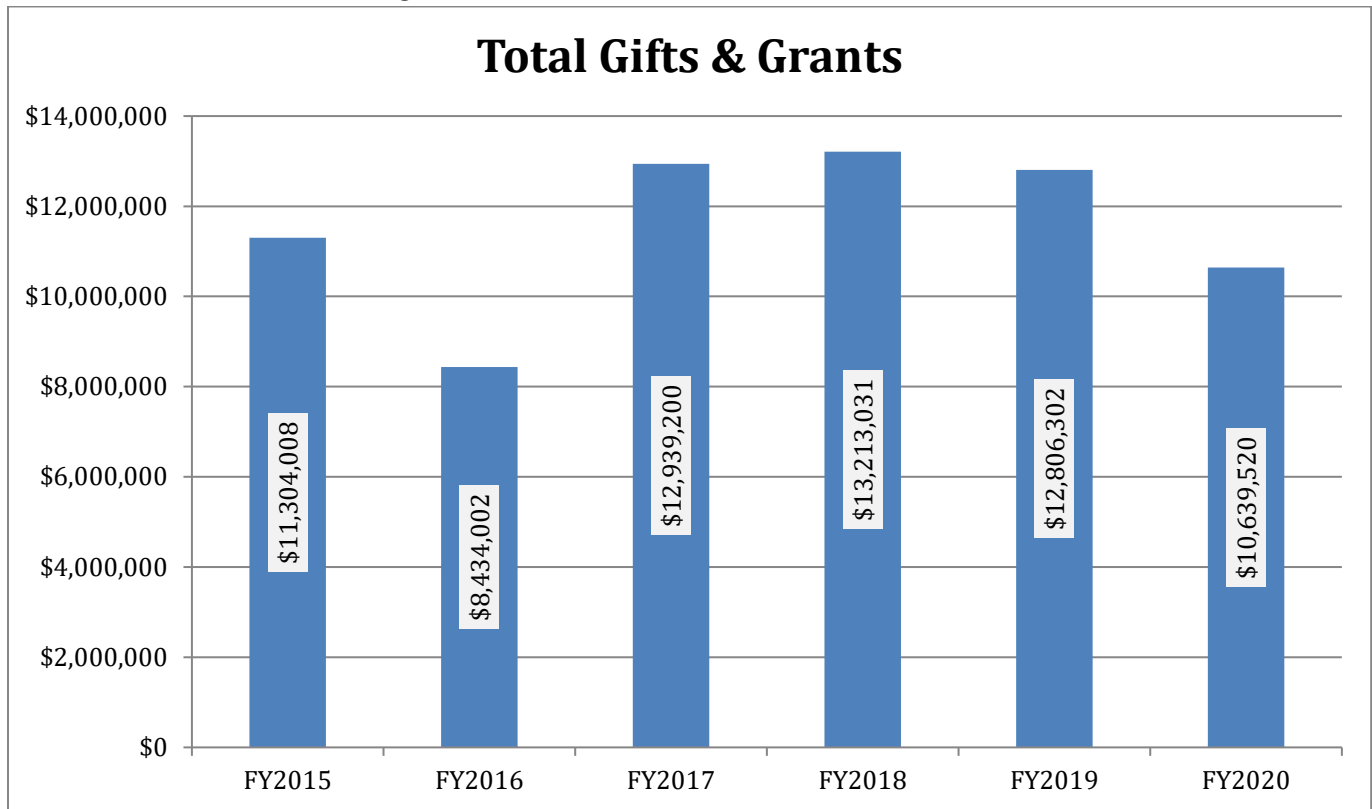

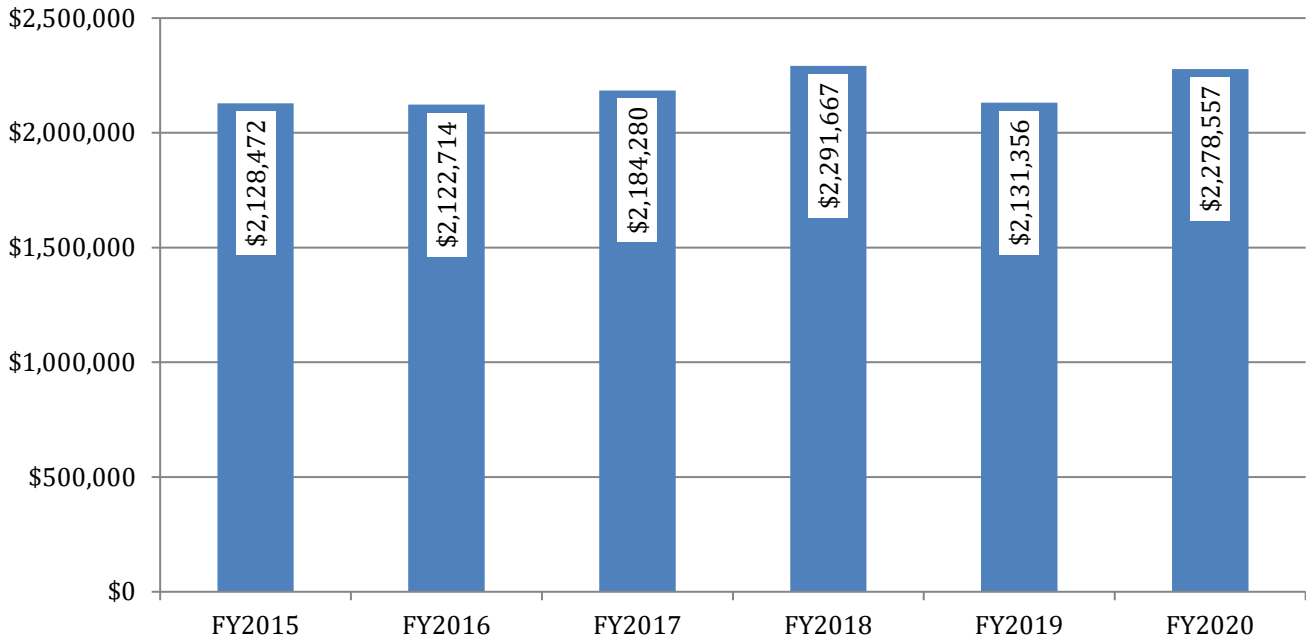


This chart measures the alumni who were solicited, donated, and the rate of giving from this group.

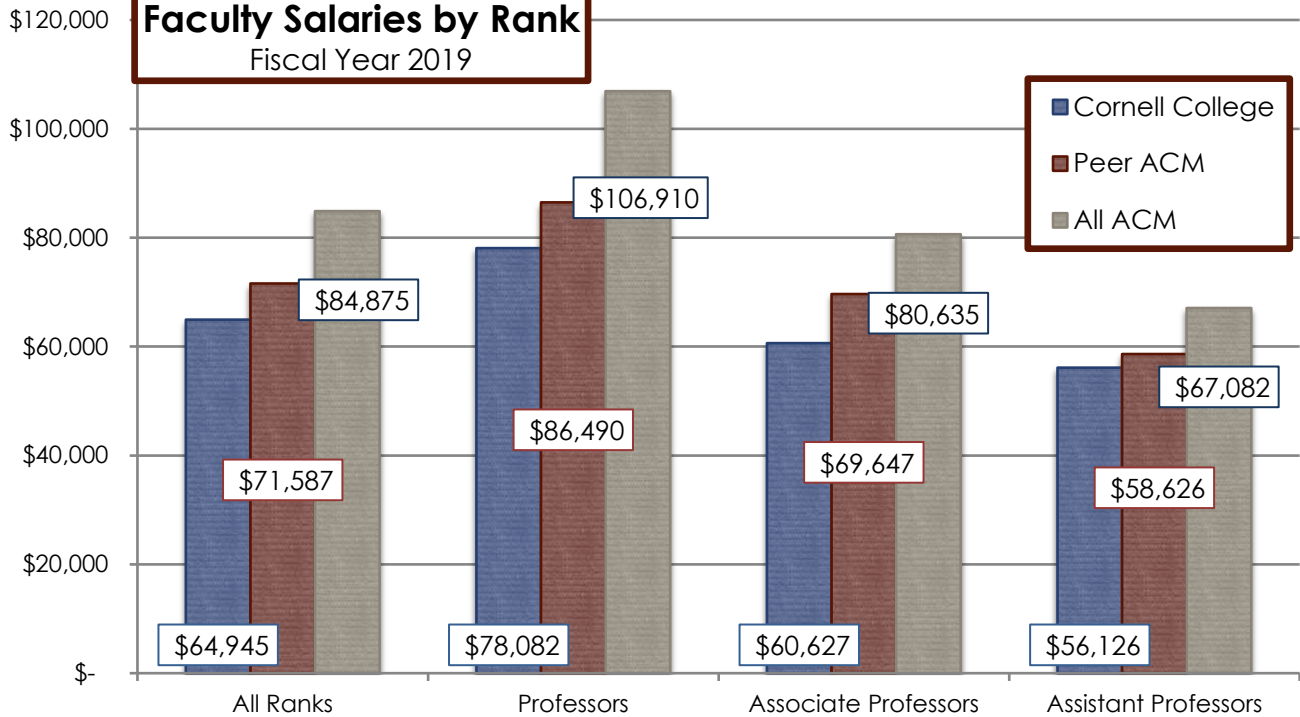

Faculty Salaries by Rank Fiscal Year 2019

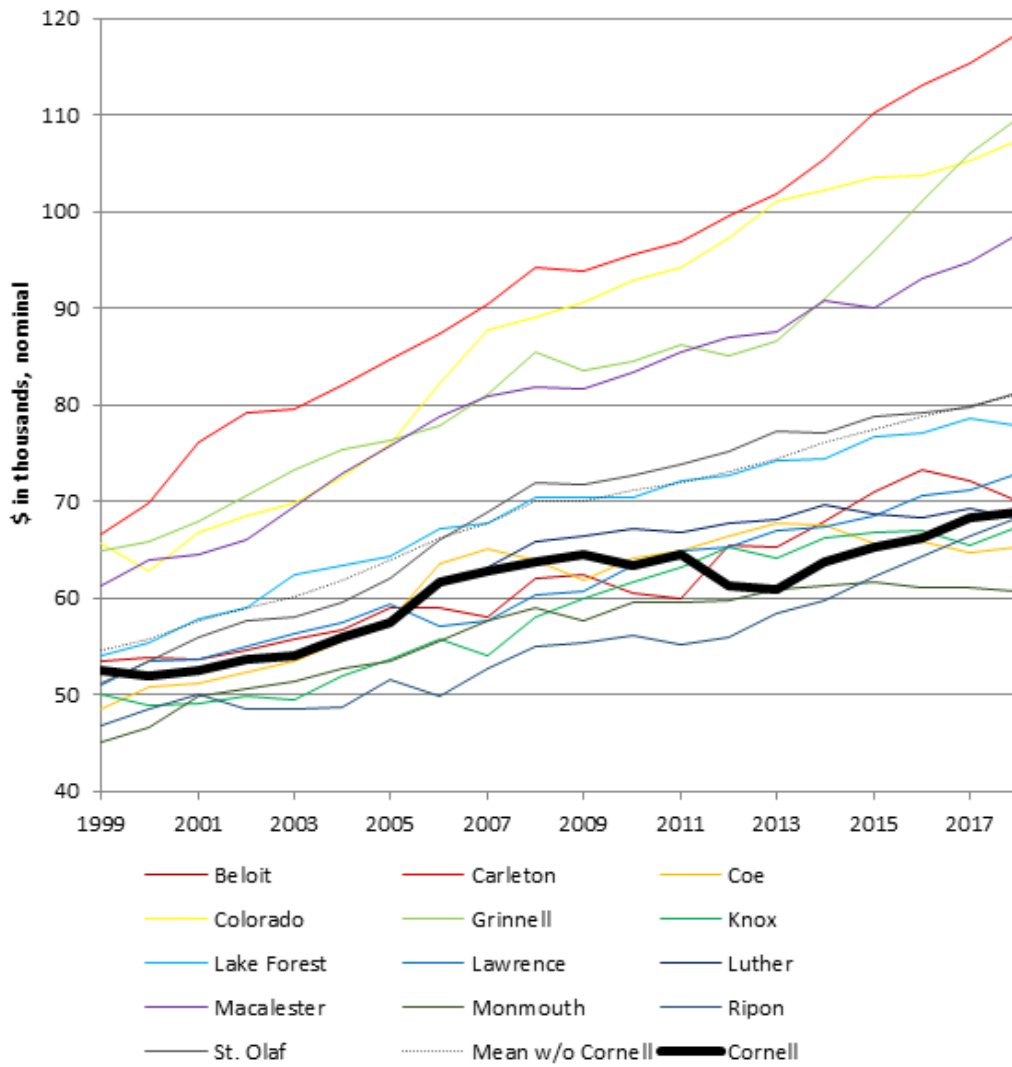

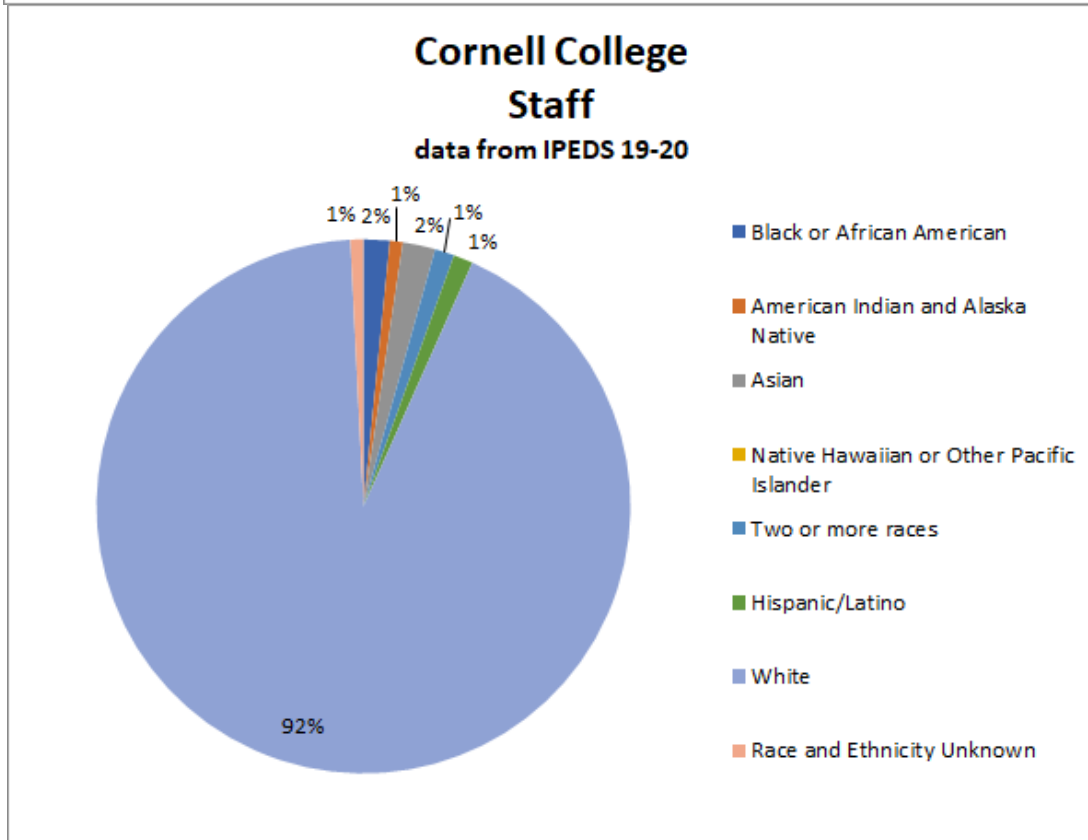
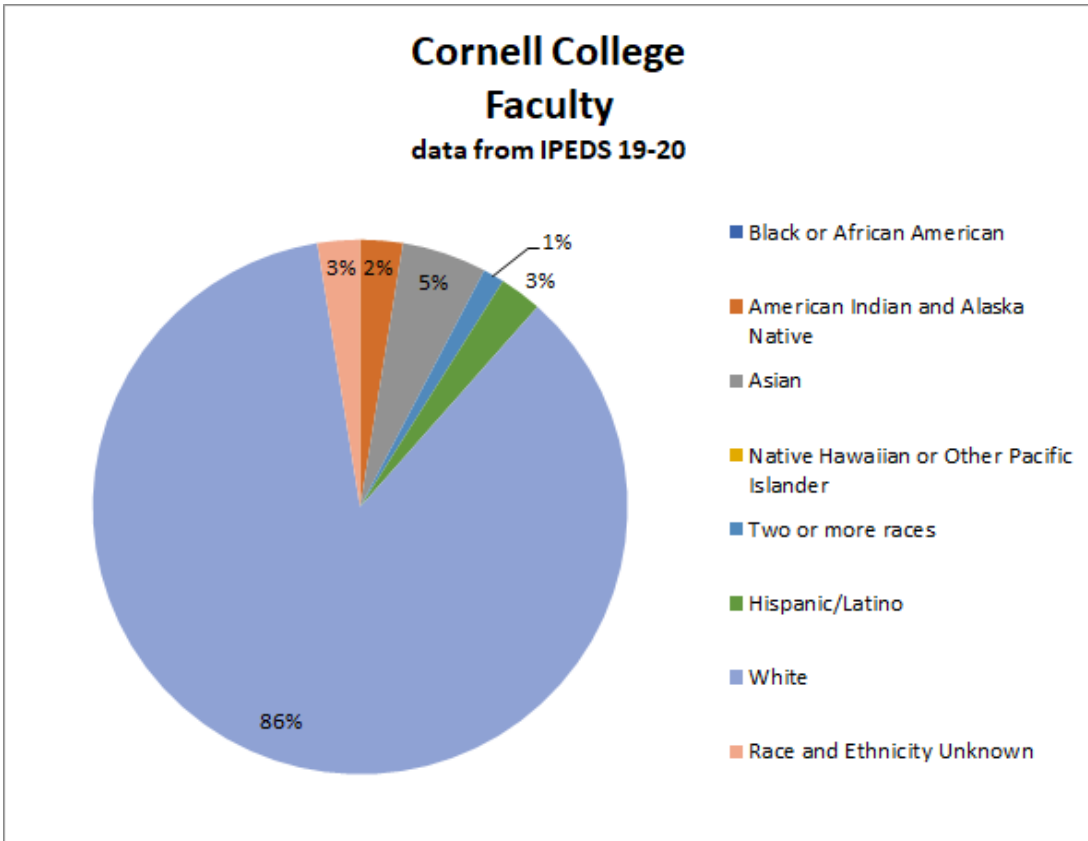
