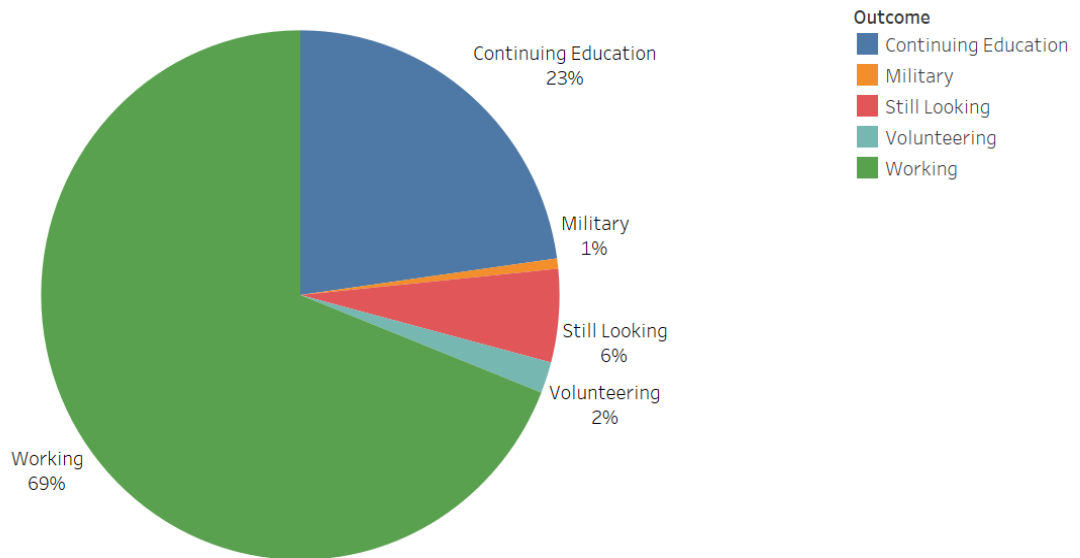

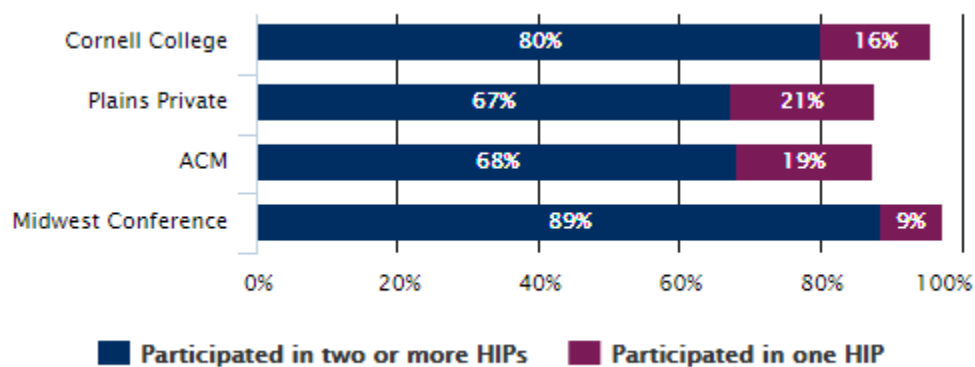

Graduates High Impact Practice Participation*

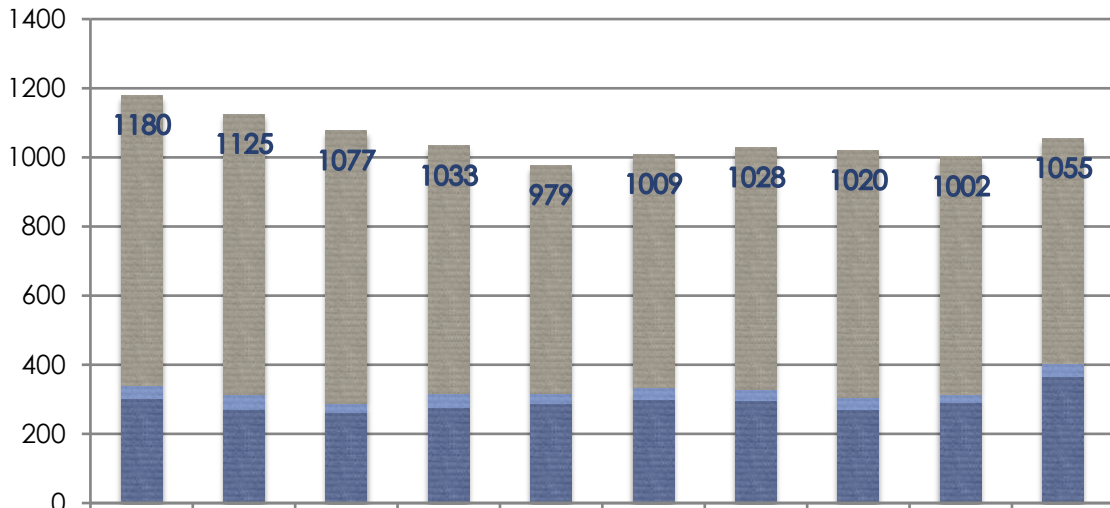

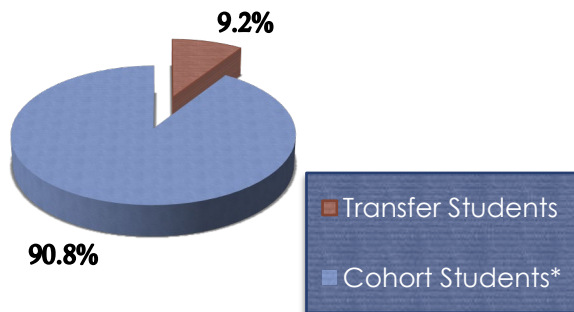

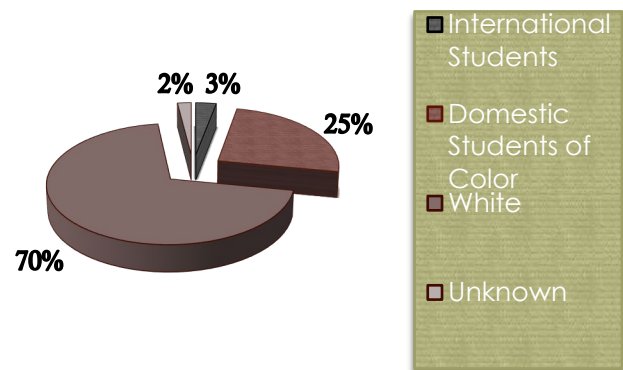

Breakdown of Students Incoming Class 2021-22

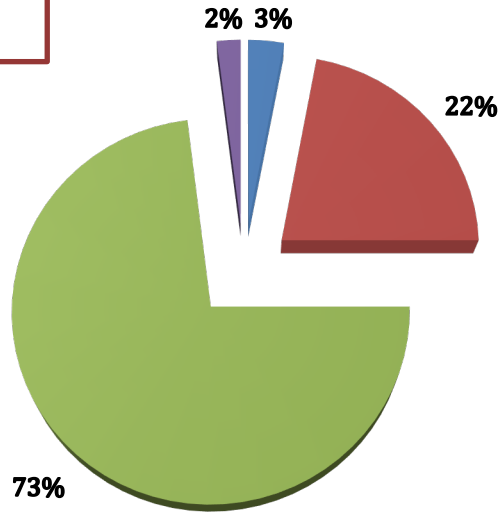


Demographic Breakdown 2021 Cohort

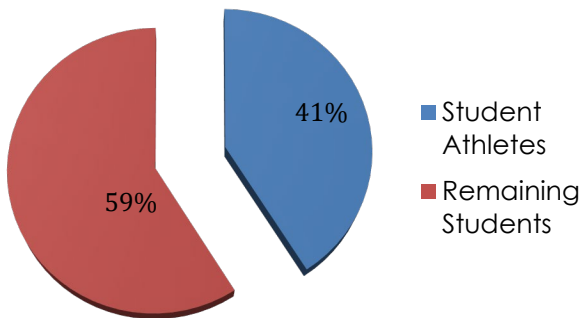

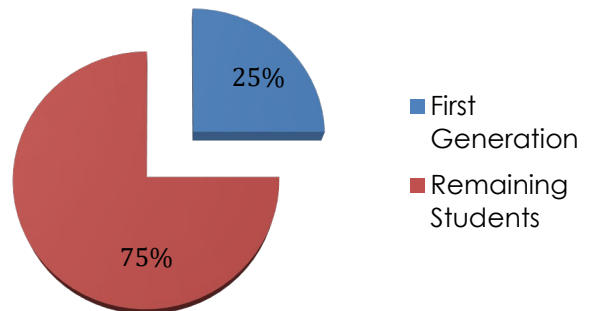

2021-22**



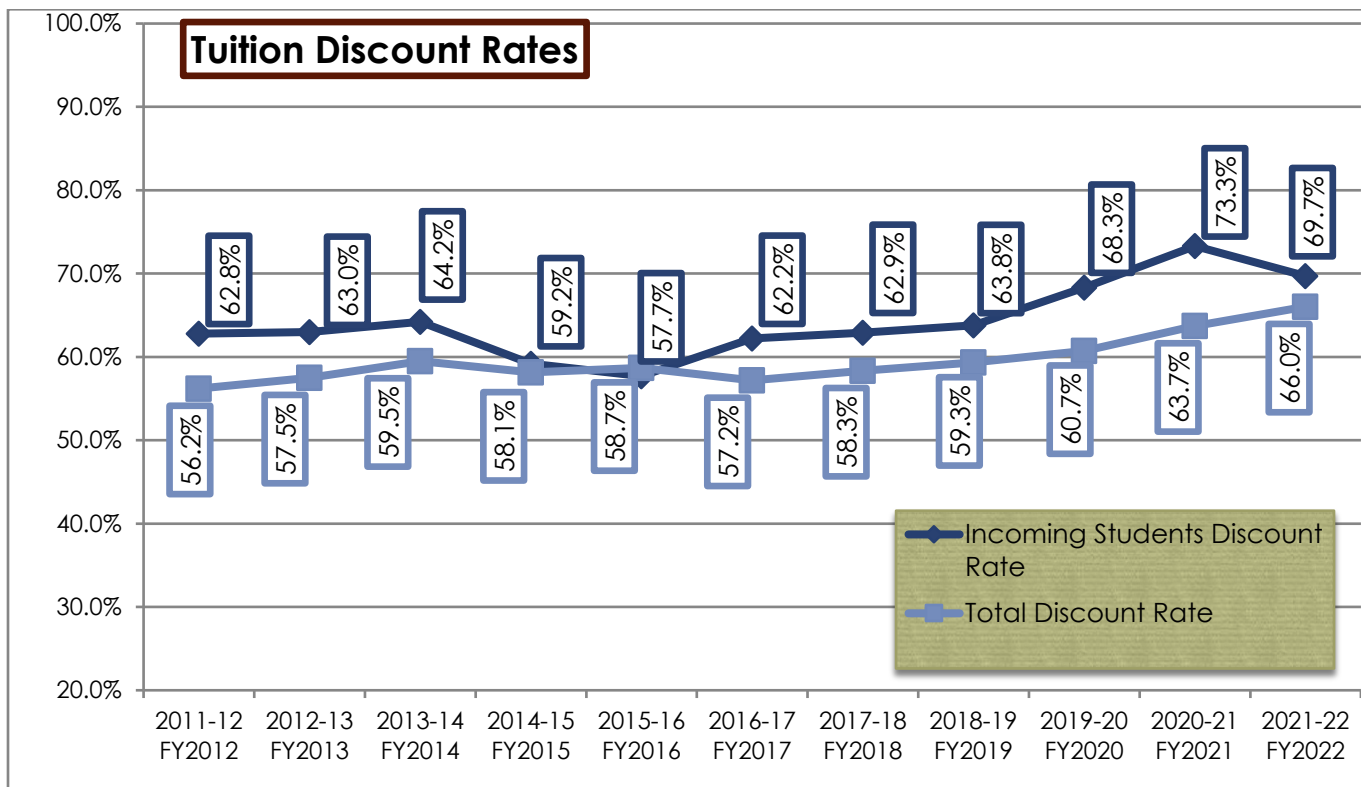

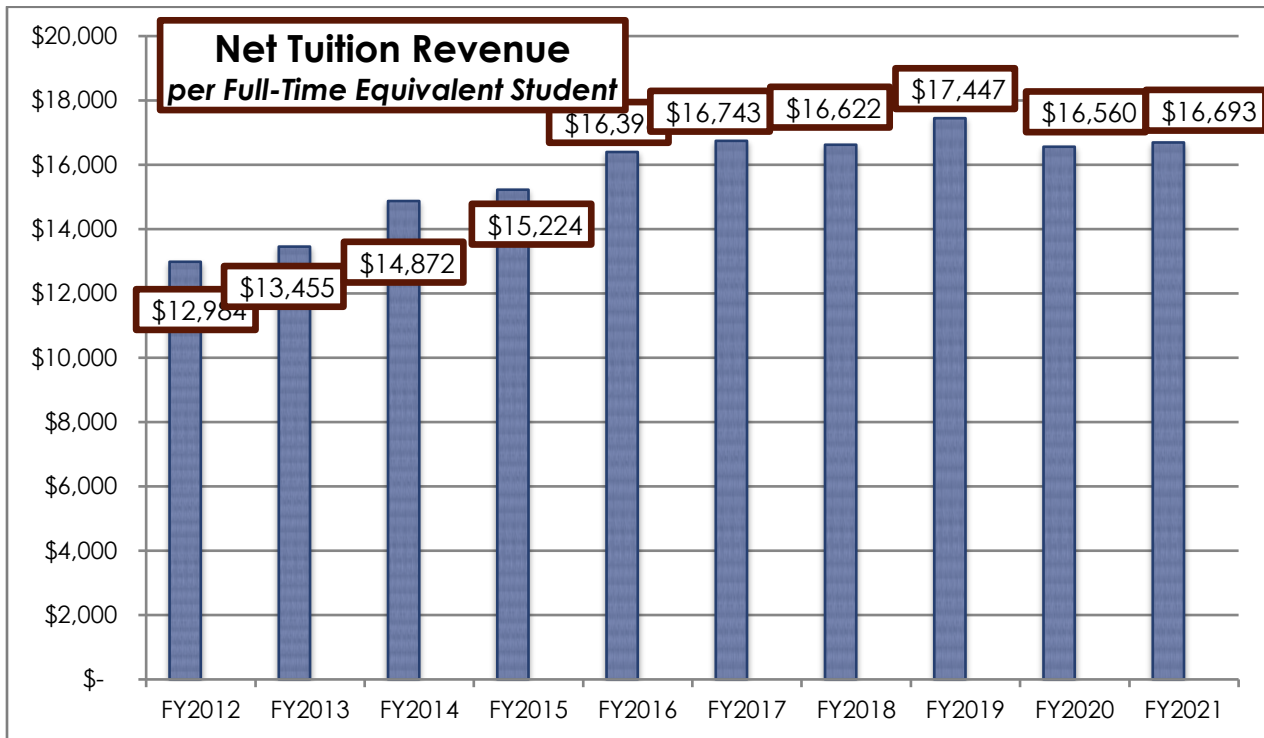

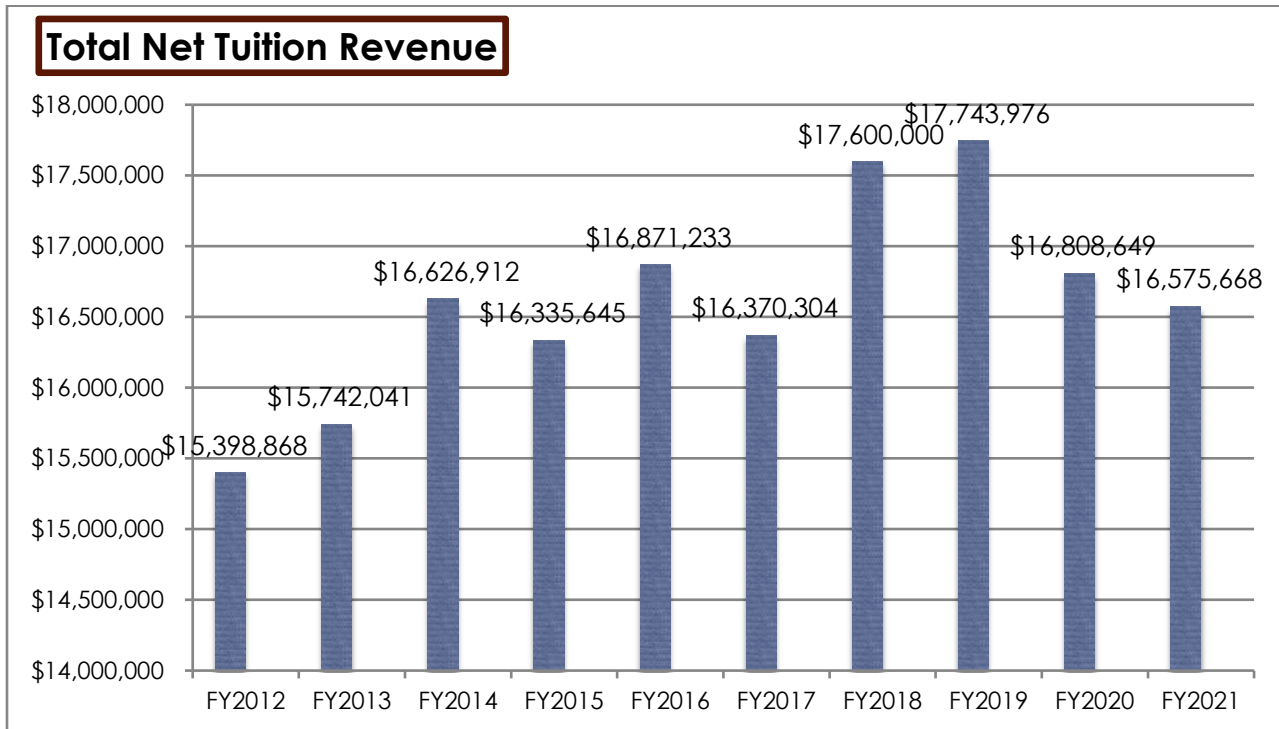

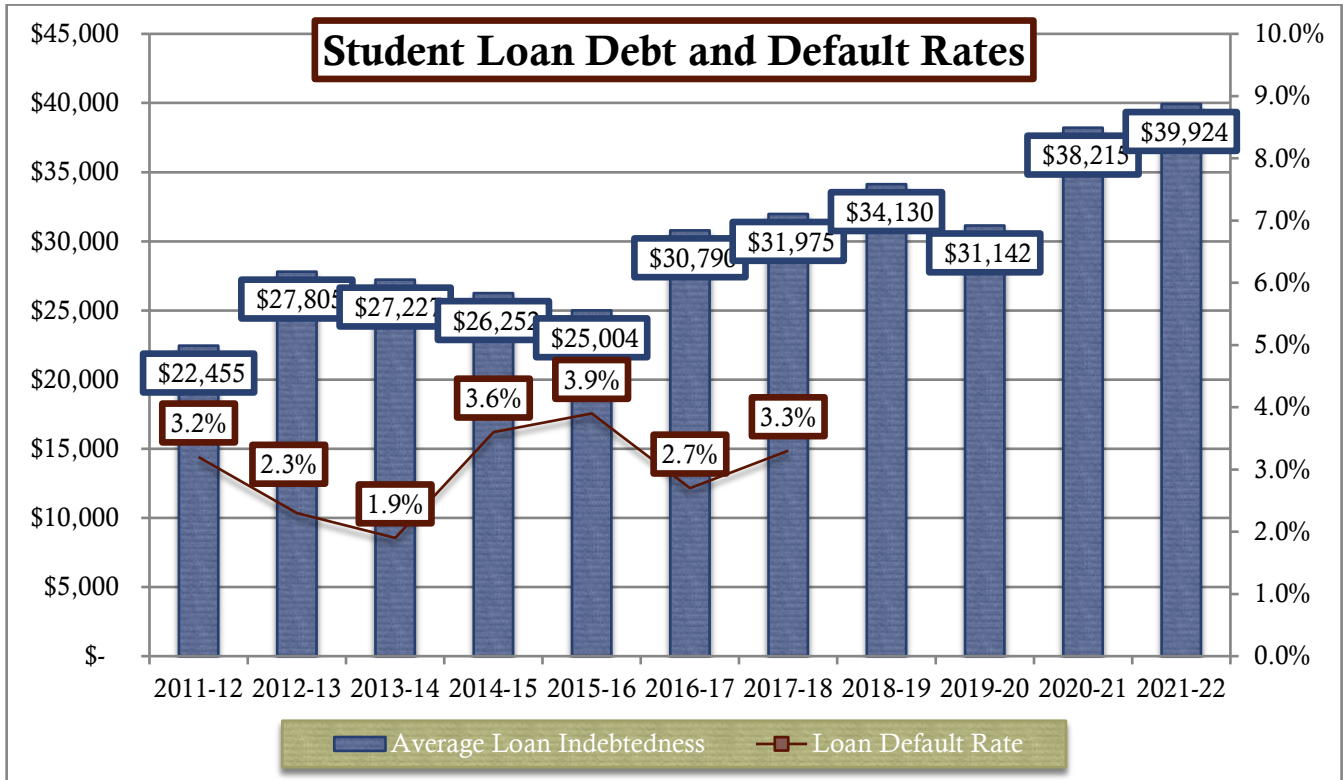

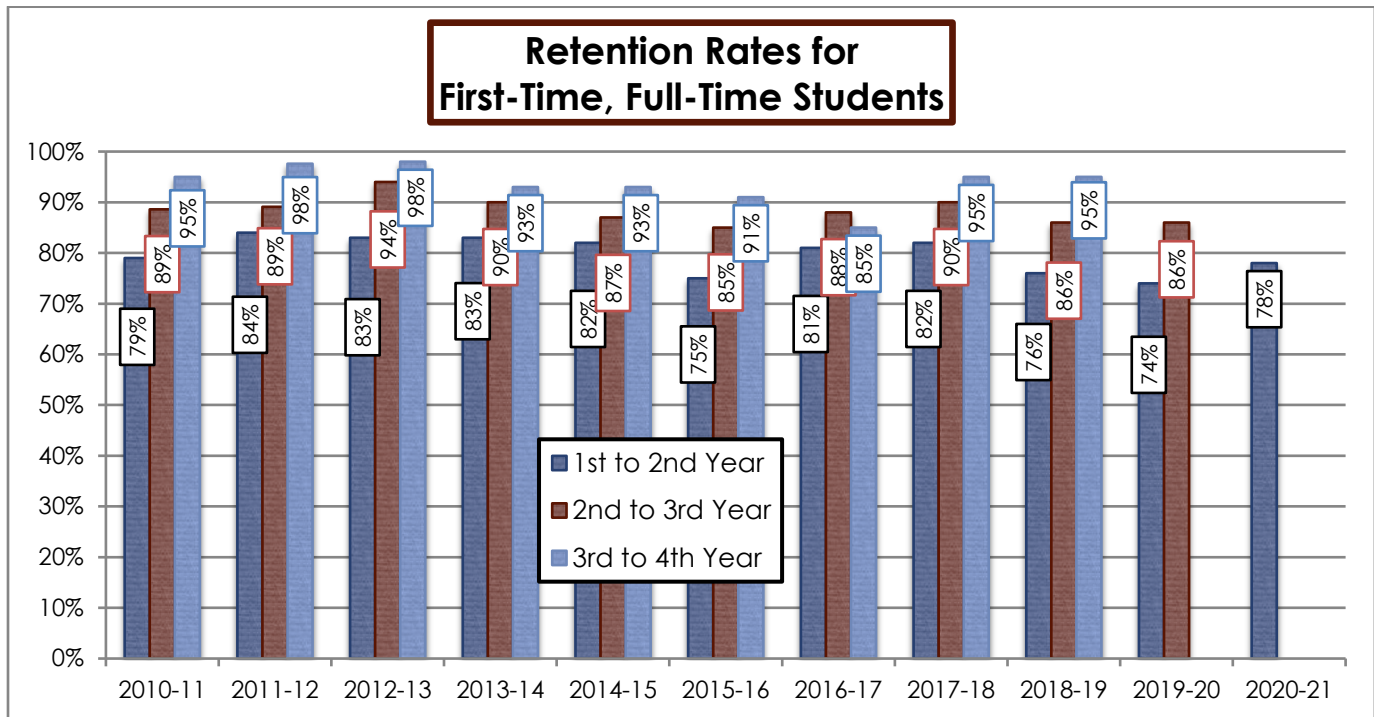

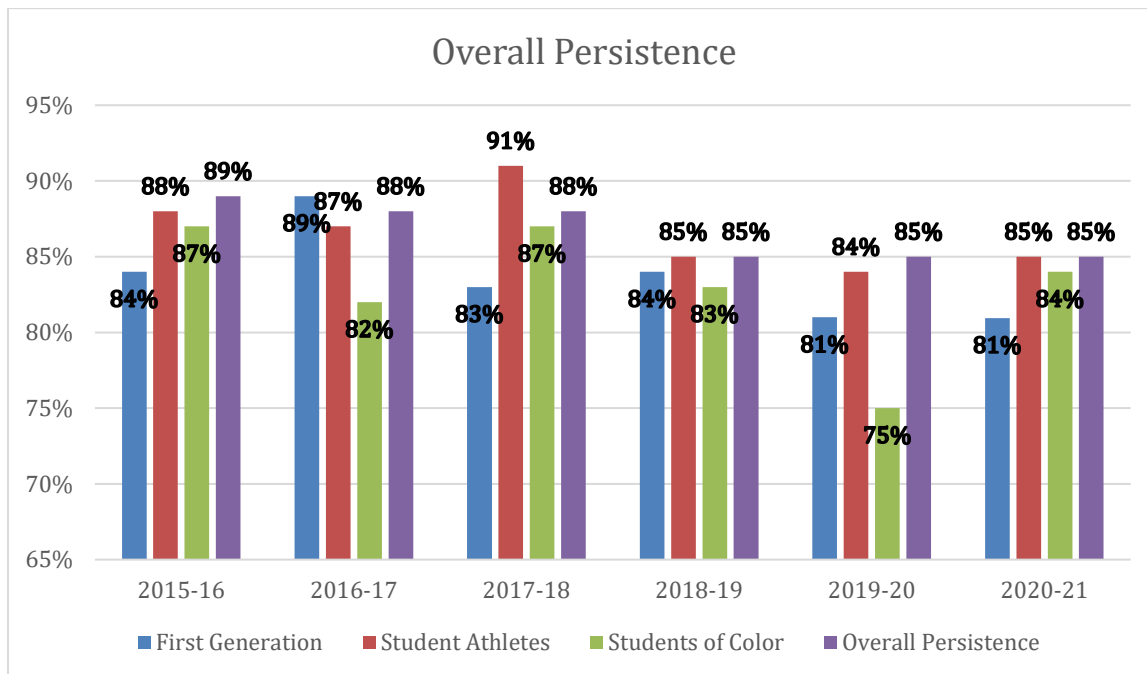

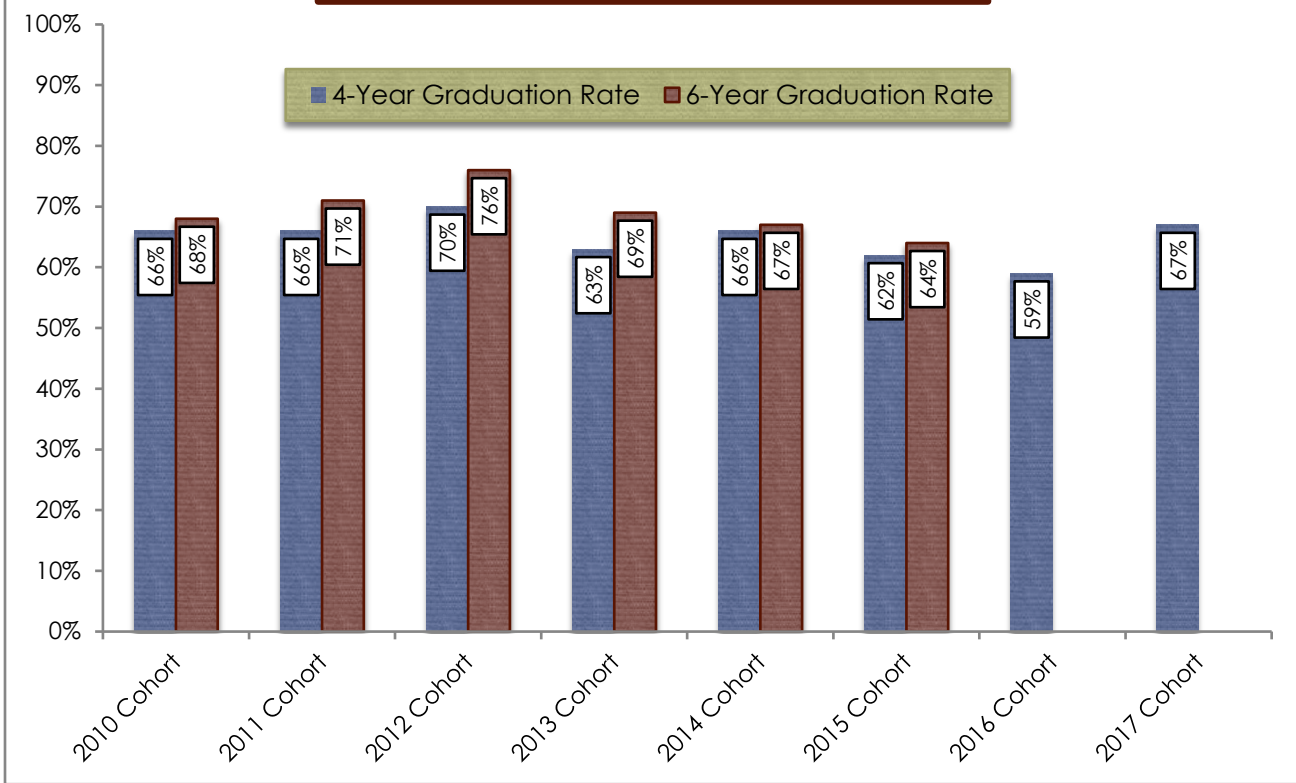

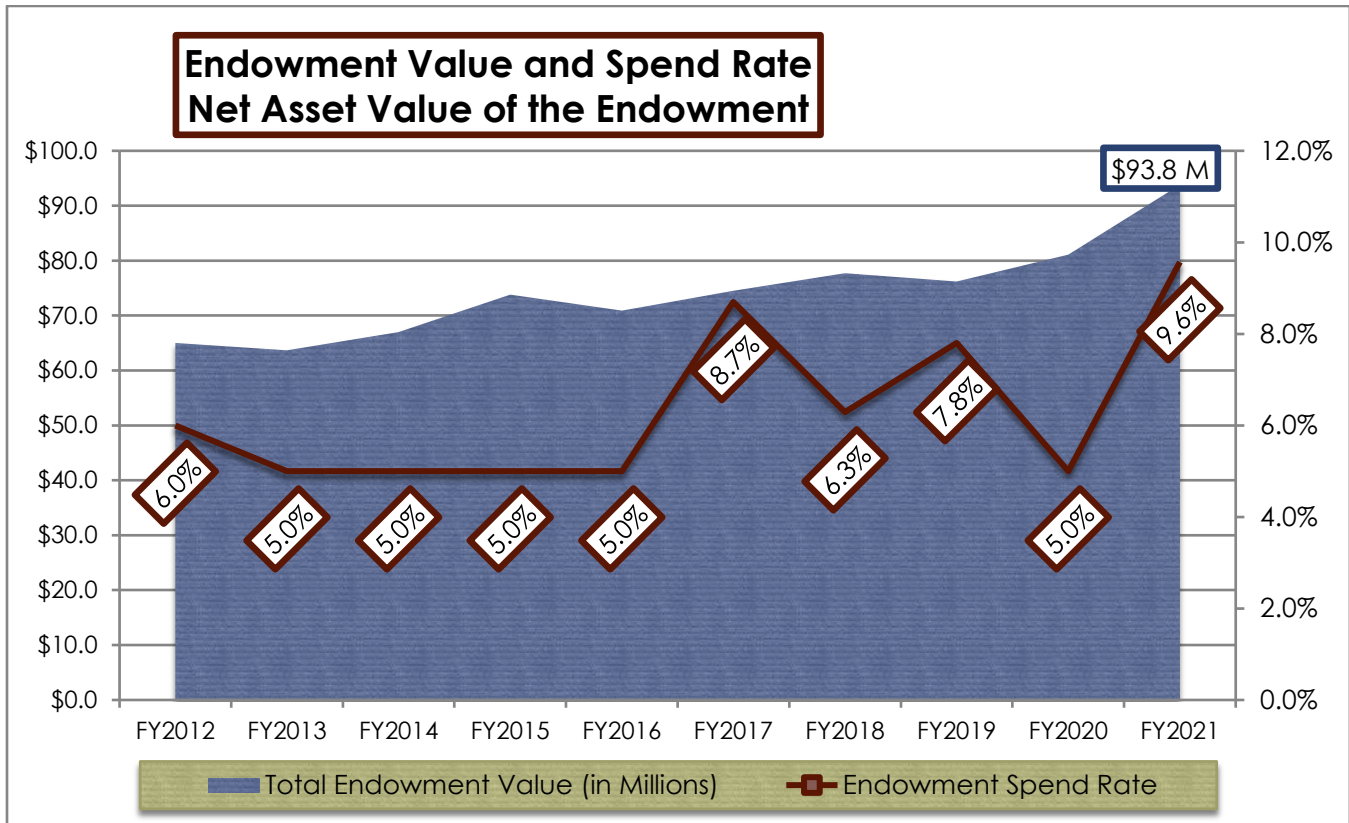

Graduation Rates of Cohort Students

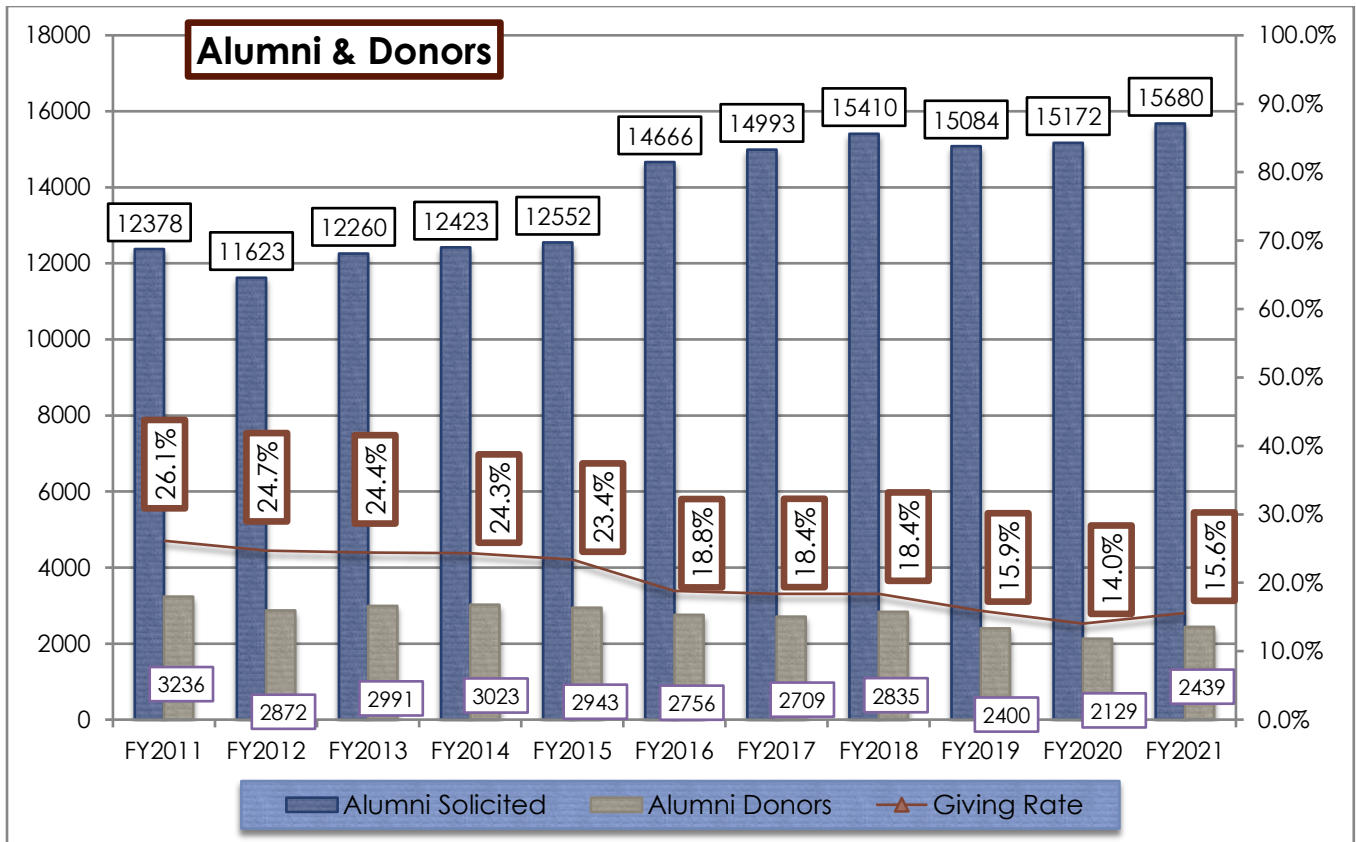

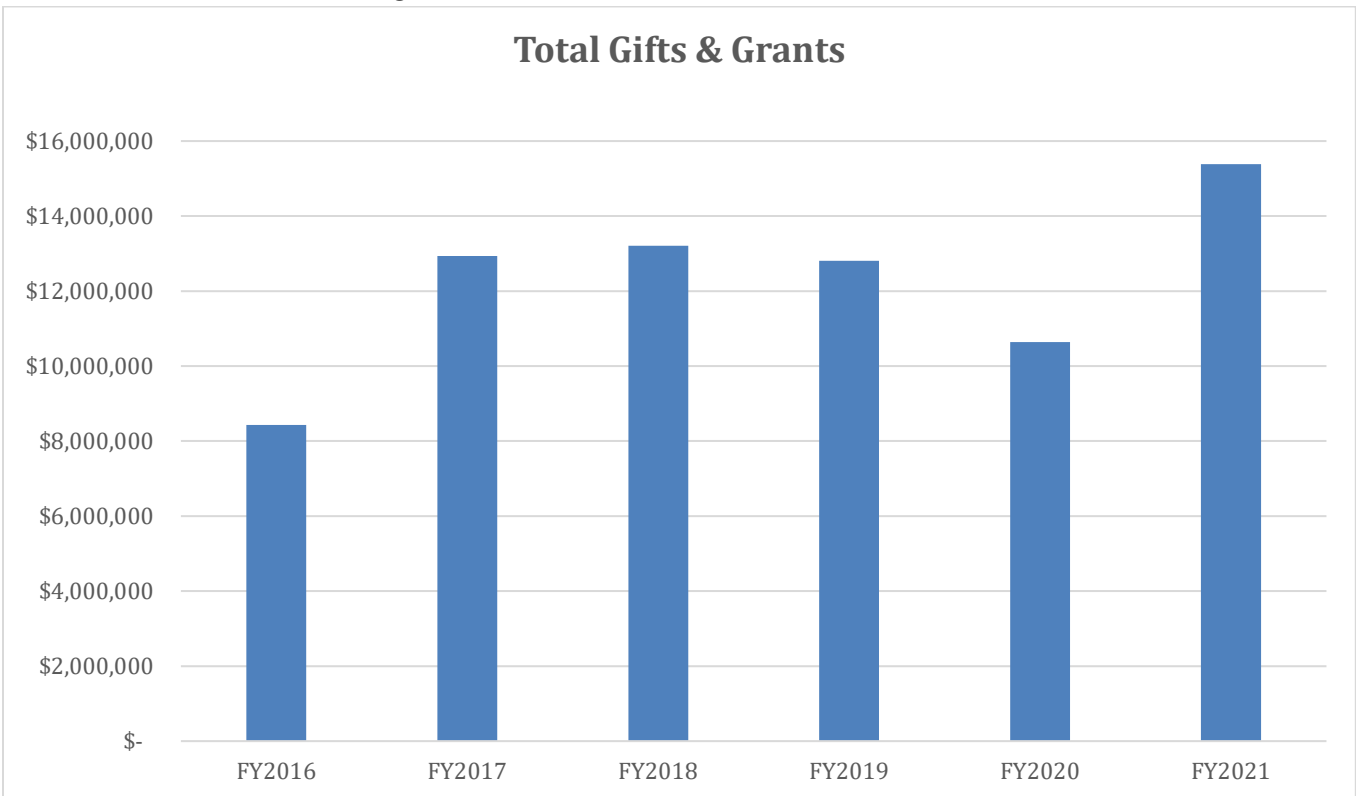
Financial Security

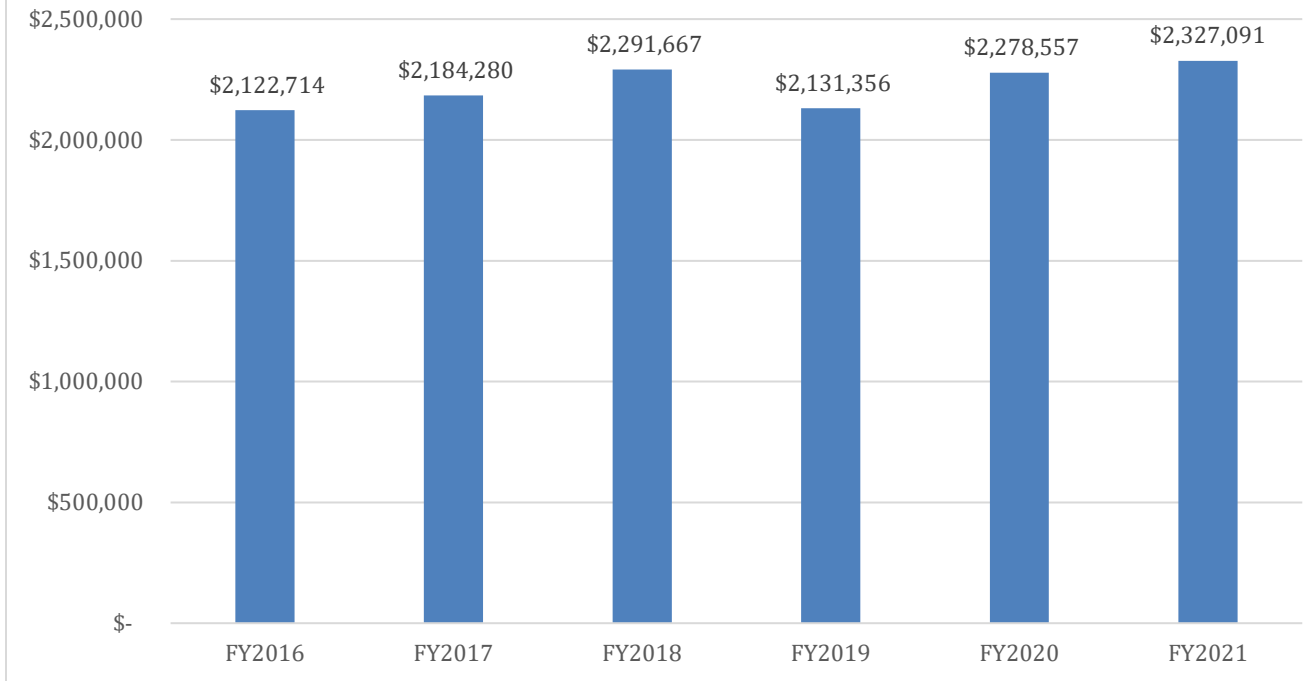


This chart measures the alumni who were solicited, donated, and the rate of giving from this group.

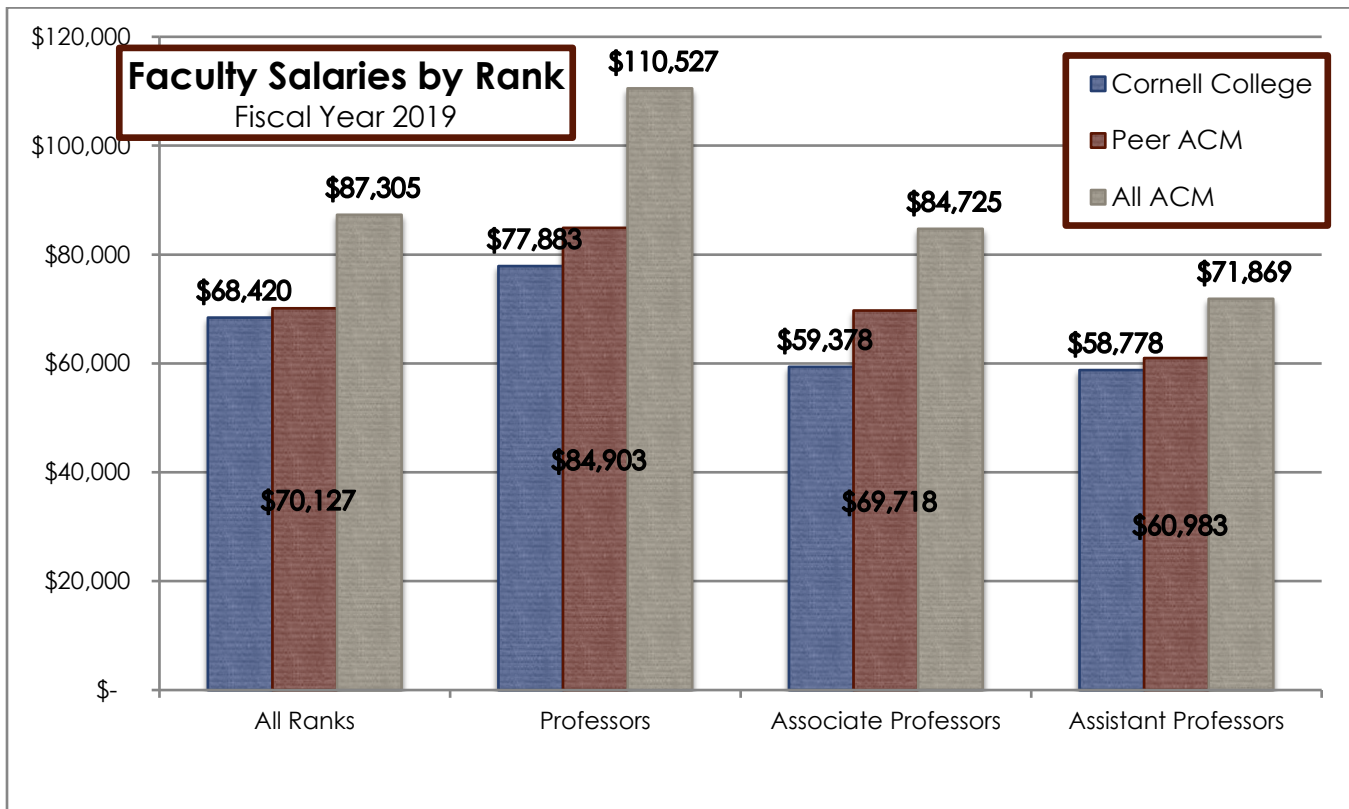

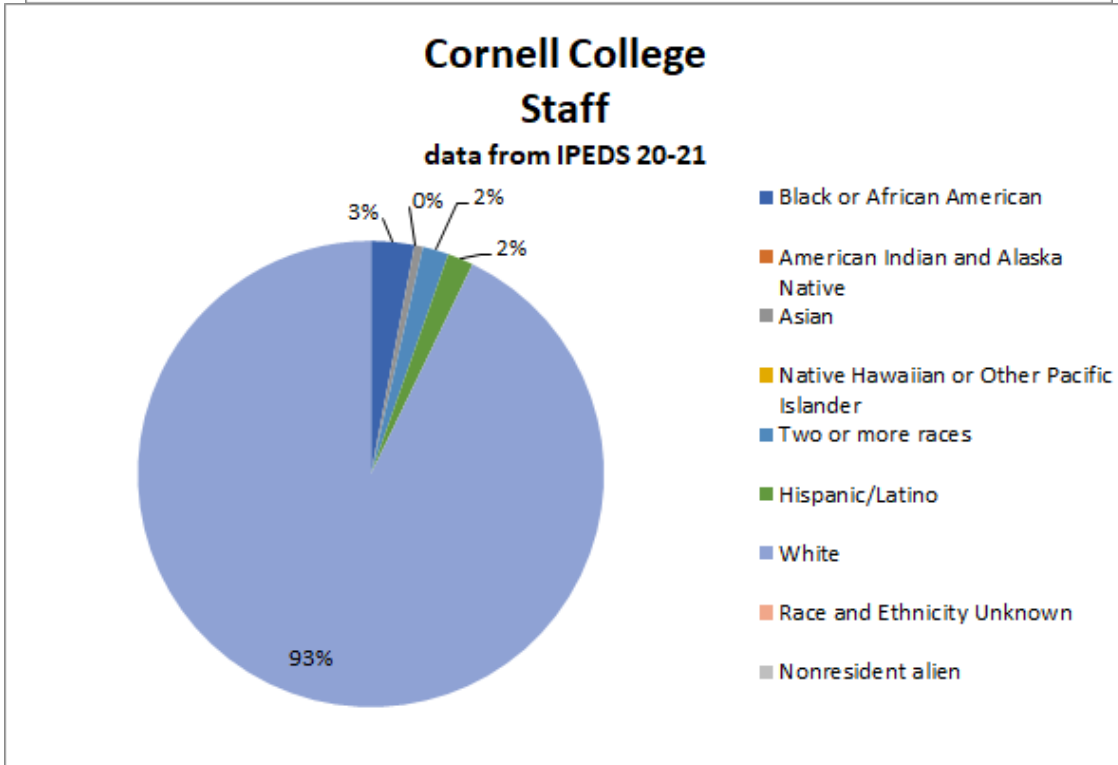
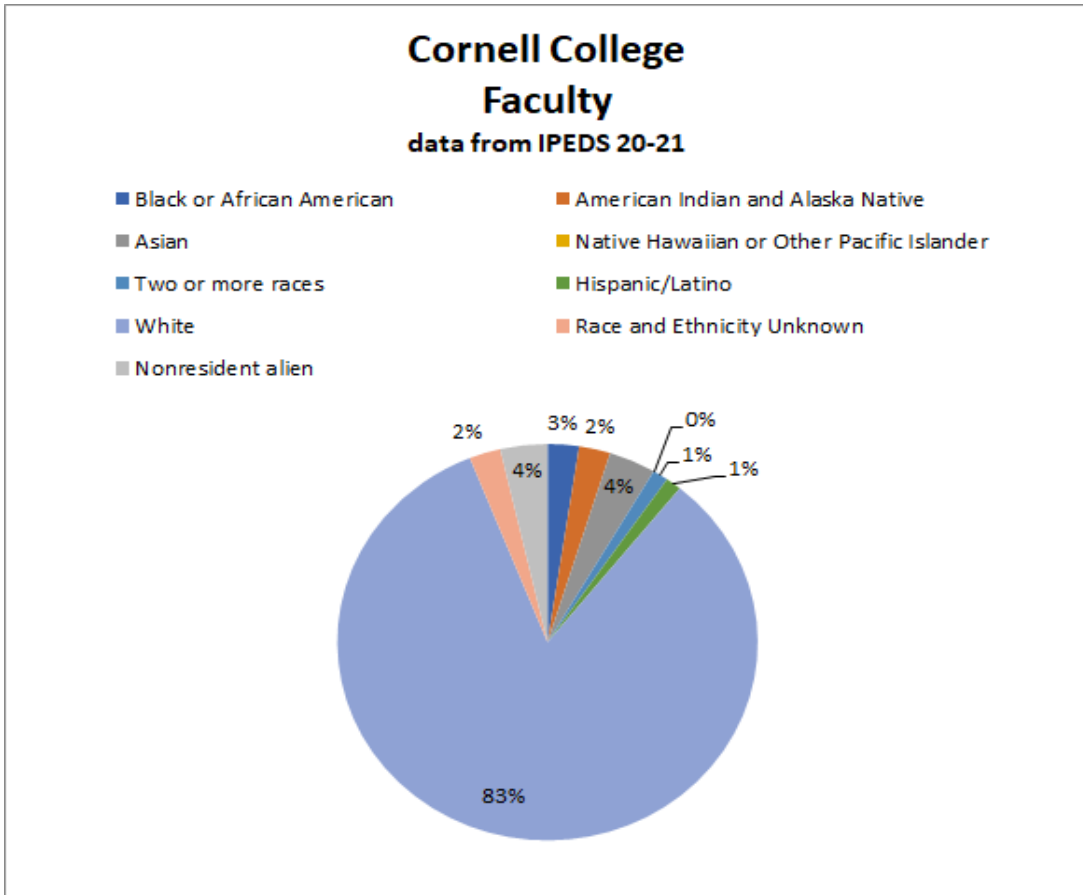
