


ETIQUETTE





- 1. Empty Pockets
- Load machine; don't
 overload, it may cause
 machine to stop working
 and will not clean clothes
- 3. Add recommended amount of detergent; if using pods, follow alternate use instructions and select preferred wash cycle
- 4. Check washing machine for any lost items and leave door open to air



- Remove clothes from washer and load into dryer; don't overload
- 2. Check and clean lint trap before and after each use
- 3. Choose dryer setting & begin cycle
- 4. Remove clothes when dry and clean lint trap before you go





- Laundry is FREE to current residential students
- This is a shared space; remove your clothes from machines promptly to make them available to others
- Items left unattended may be considered abandoned and will be discarded or donated














DO NOT IRON

DO NOT STEAM

DO NOT skip the spin cycle!

- Always run the spin cycle.
- The dryer needs it.
- Skipping spin doesn't save time.
- If dryer somehow dries soaked clothes it will take longer than the spin cycle and hurt the dryer.
